Priority Post Courier service will not operate on Monday, Oct. 13.

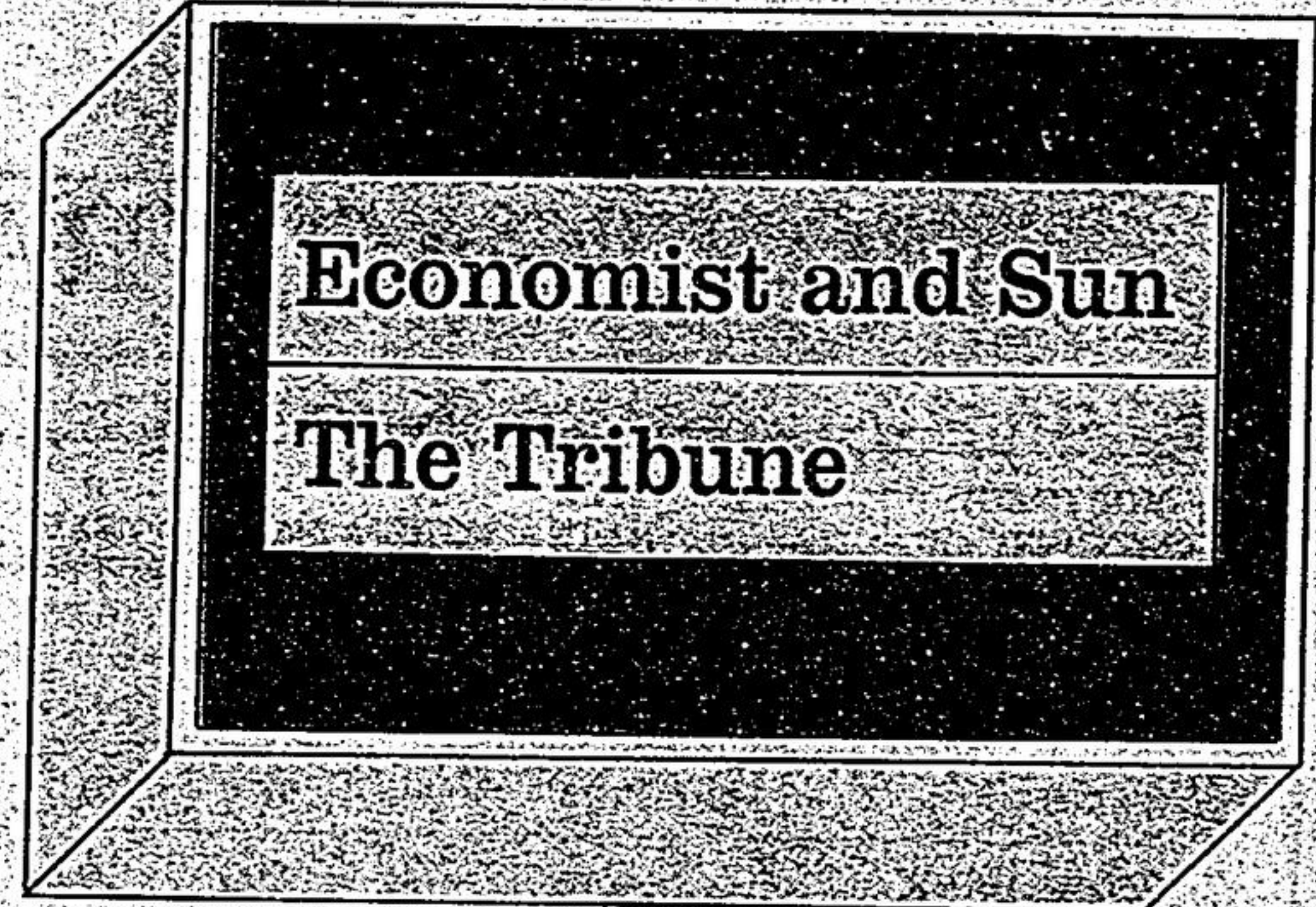
Regular postal service will resume on Tuesday, Oct. 14.

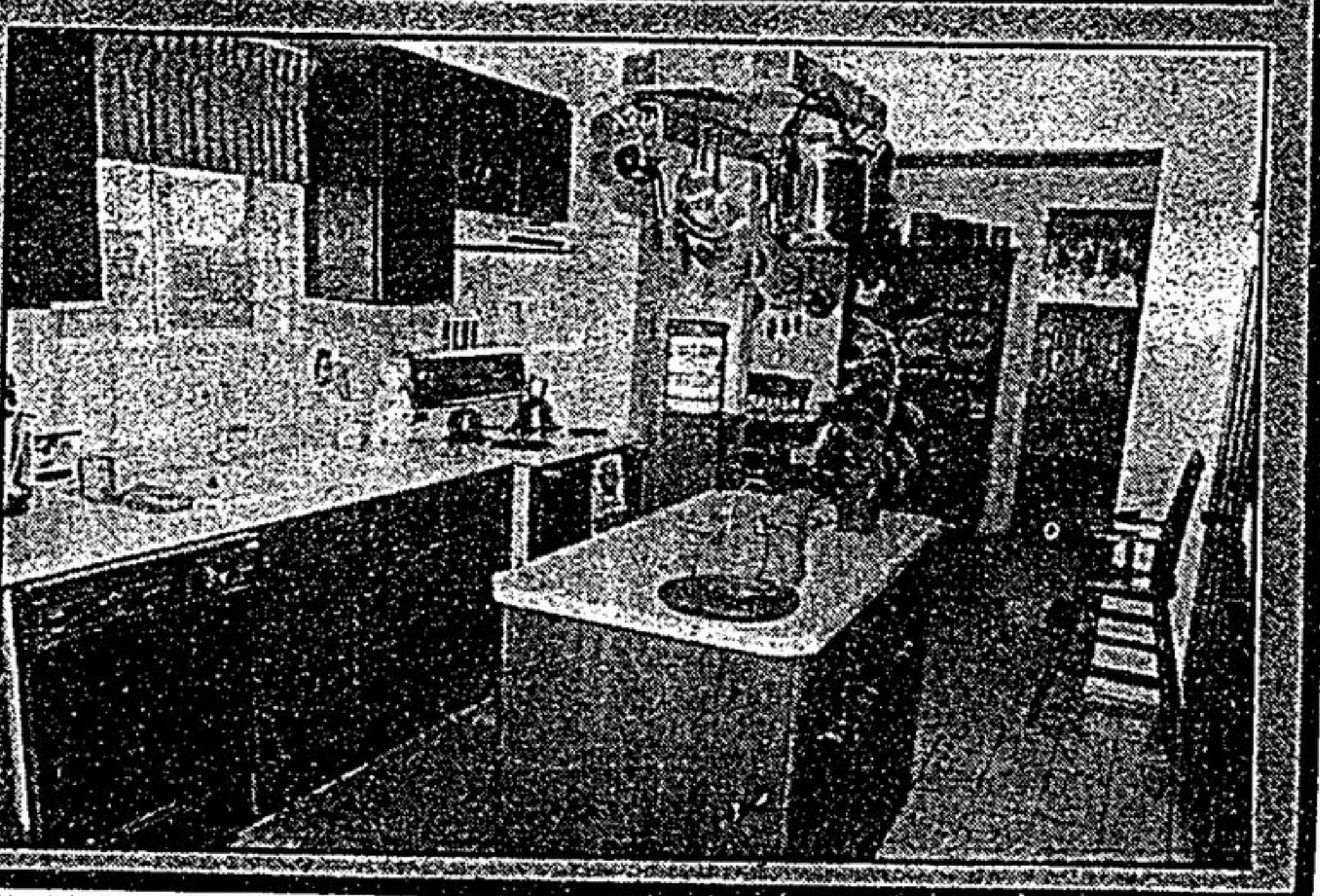
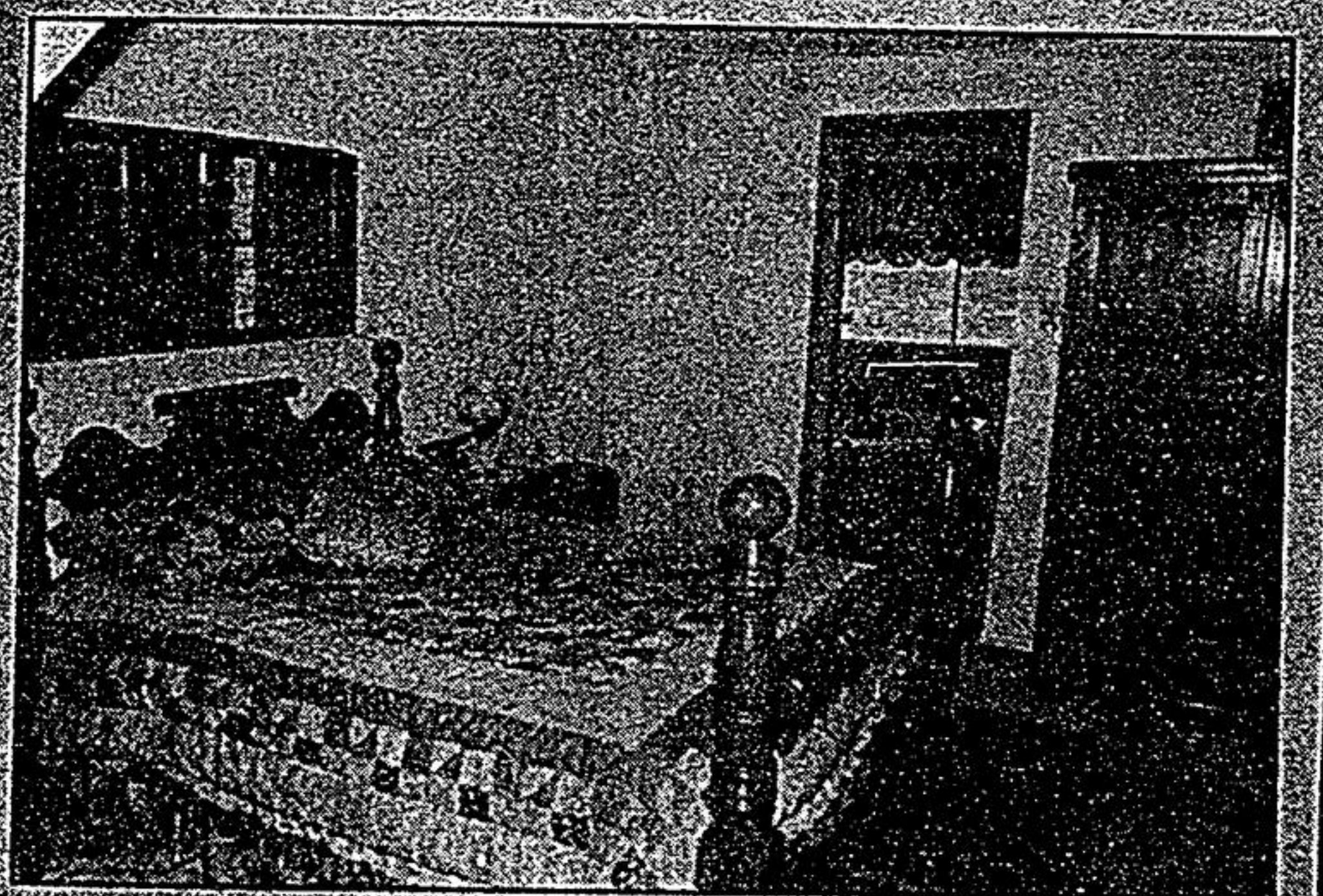
