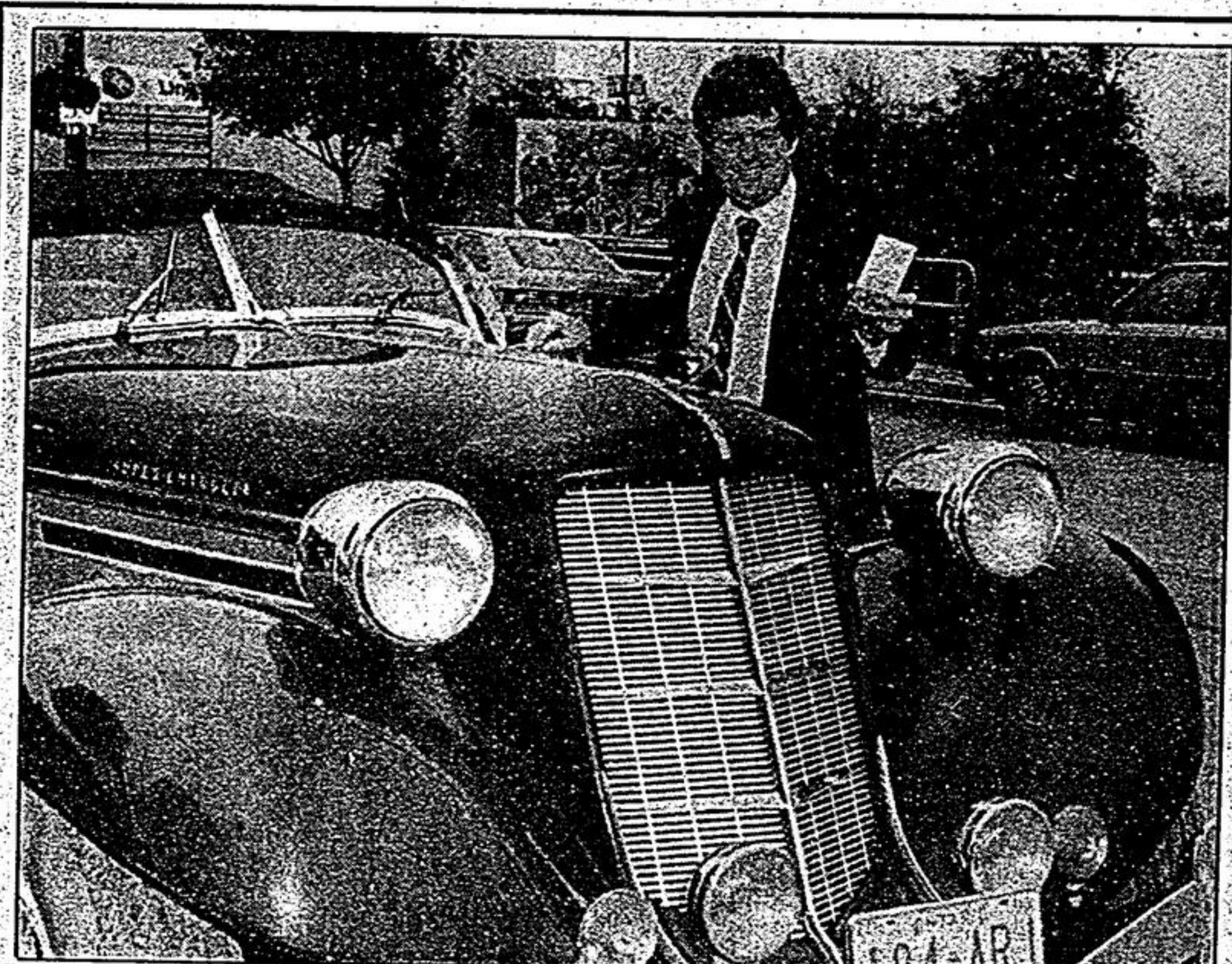
About twelve years ago, Mr. and Mrs. Mercer left Claremont to reside in a trailer park at R.R. 4, Lindsay. Her husband survives.

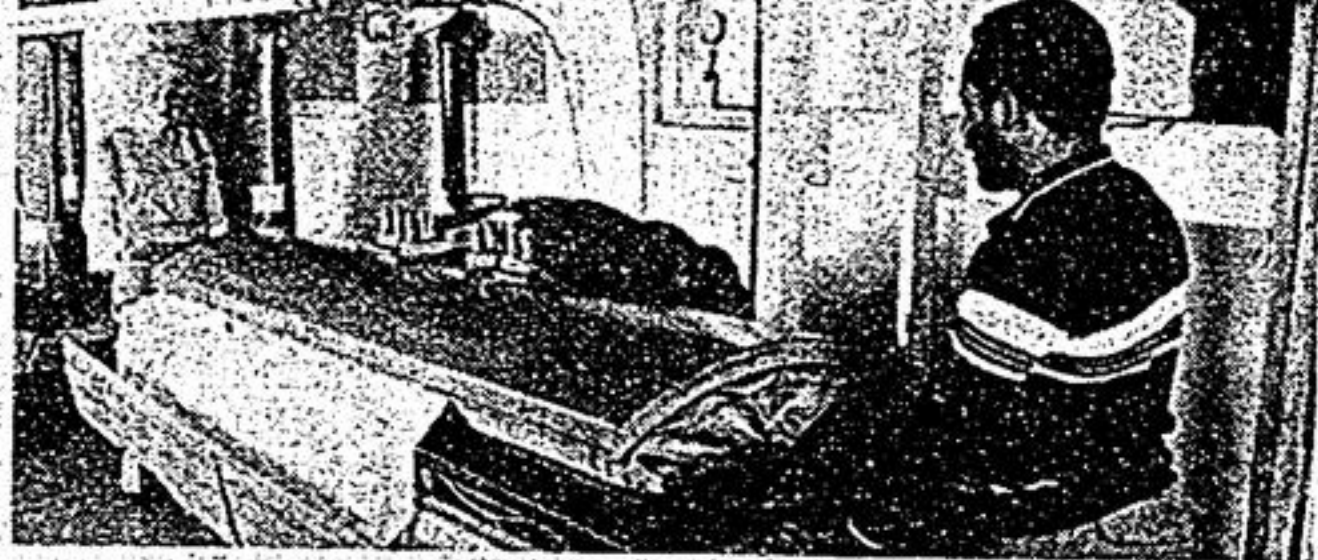

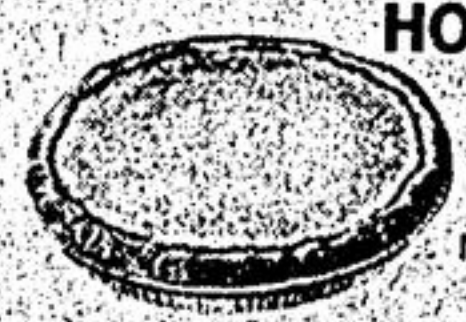
