

Drivers charged

UXBRIDGE TWP. — Durham Regional Police have charged both drivers involved in an Aug. 28 crash between a school bus and dump truck.

The driver of the bus, 30-year-old Ronald Henshaw of Whitby, and truck driver Daniel Henry each face separate counts of careless driving. Henry, 44, of Holland Landing, has also been charged with operating an unsafe motor vehicle.

Police conducted a lengthy investigation into the accident in

conjunction with the Crown Attorney's office.

Dozens of passengers suffered minor injuries when a Charterways bus loaded with children and camp counsellors collided with a truck on Brock Road near the entrance to Pleasure Park.

Nearly 50 members of the Whitby Youth Action group at St. John the Evangelist Catholic Church were on their way to a day-long outing at the Uxbridge Twp. facility at the time of the mishap.
