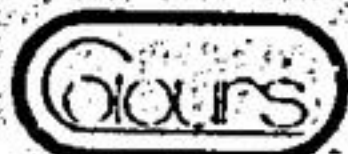
A person's skin tone dictates what colour clothes look right and wrong according to wardrobe consultant Susan Smith. And she should know. Colours are Mrs. Smith's business.
