Residents fight to preserve historic Buttonville hamlet

Gary Leak is optimistic that Buttonville's historic character can be retained — even while progress knocks at the hamlet's front door.

Mr. Leak, co-chairman of the Buttonville Ratepayers Association, succeeded in a residents' drive recently to have the area designated a heritage conservation study district.

Thornhill was recently designated a heritage conservation district while Unionville and Markham Village went through the process in recent years.

"Our goal is preservation — it comes back to our not wishing anything to change," he said recently. "But we realize we'll have to compromise."

The association faced a difference of opinion with some councillors over the boundaries of the study area, but agreed to be flexible as the study progresses.

Some councillors were against the association's proposal to include lands north of 16th Ave.

Mr. Leak pointed out that land and homeowners living on heritage land or in century houses aren't obligated to have their properties or structures designated.

However, he said local ratepayers are adamant that the historical character of the hamlet be

retained in spite of inevitable growth in the area.

If not preserved "100 years from now our children and grandchildren are going to look at us and say 'you guys let it all go,'" he noted.

He said the study group, made up of himself, Buttonville residents Susan Casella and Dorothy Reesor, Councillors Frank Scar-

pitti and Elson Miles and Heritage Markham's Bill Wylie and Peter Williams, will take part in the study.

Public meetings will be held regularly to gain input from landowners and a report will be submitted to council when the study is completed.

Mr. Leak speculated that the study would take about one year.

Developer, councillors agree on preservation

Buttonville developer Iona-Avalon Inc. reached a compromise with council Tuesday on a local heritage property's preservation plan.

Spokesman Gerard Gervais convinced members to permit a landscaping plan on the historic Burr property to screen and separate it from new homes being built in the area.

The plan includes a property fence, tree barriers and a rear retaining wall to isolate the house from newer models.

Council originally wanted an additional 25 feet on the property as part of its preservation order to the developer.

Iona-Avalon also received

approval at the meeting to construct 15 model homes in the area.

In a separate development during the discussion, Mr. Gervais informed Council that a wall constructed at Iona-Avalon's sales office would be taken down.

Buttonville residents were recently up in arms about the wall's construction at the Woodbine Ave. building and demanded a stop to it.

Mr. Gervais said the landscaping scheme would achieve the objectives the town demanded.


"We'll build a privacy fence around the Burr house so it's not visible to owners in the new homes," he noted.
