NOTICE OF MEETING
 TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville will hold a further public meeting on TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4TH, 1986 at 8:00 p.m. in LATCHAM HALL located at 32 PARK DRIVE SOUTH, STOUFFVILLE, Ontario to make available adequate information to the public regarding, and to consider, the proposed GENERAL ZONING BY-LAW to be passed pursuant to Section 34 of the Planning Act.

SUBJECT PROPERTY
 The proposed General Zoning By-law will apply to ALL LANDS WITHIN THE TOWN OF WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
 The proposed General Zoning By-law will, among other matters, do the following:
 Replace Zoning By-law No. 72-7,
 Consolidate the numerous Zoning By-law Amendments,
 Convert measurements from imperial to metric units,
 Modify present zoning categories,
 Introduce new zoning categories,
 Change the zoning on selected properties and neighbourhoods,
 and,
 Implement the Official Plan as amended.

REPRESENTATION
 ANY person may attend the public meeting and make written or oral representation either in support of or in opposition to the proposed General Zoning By-law. If you are unable to attend, written submissions will be received up to the time of the meeting.
