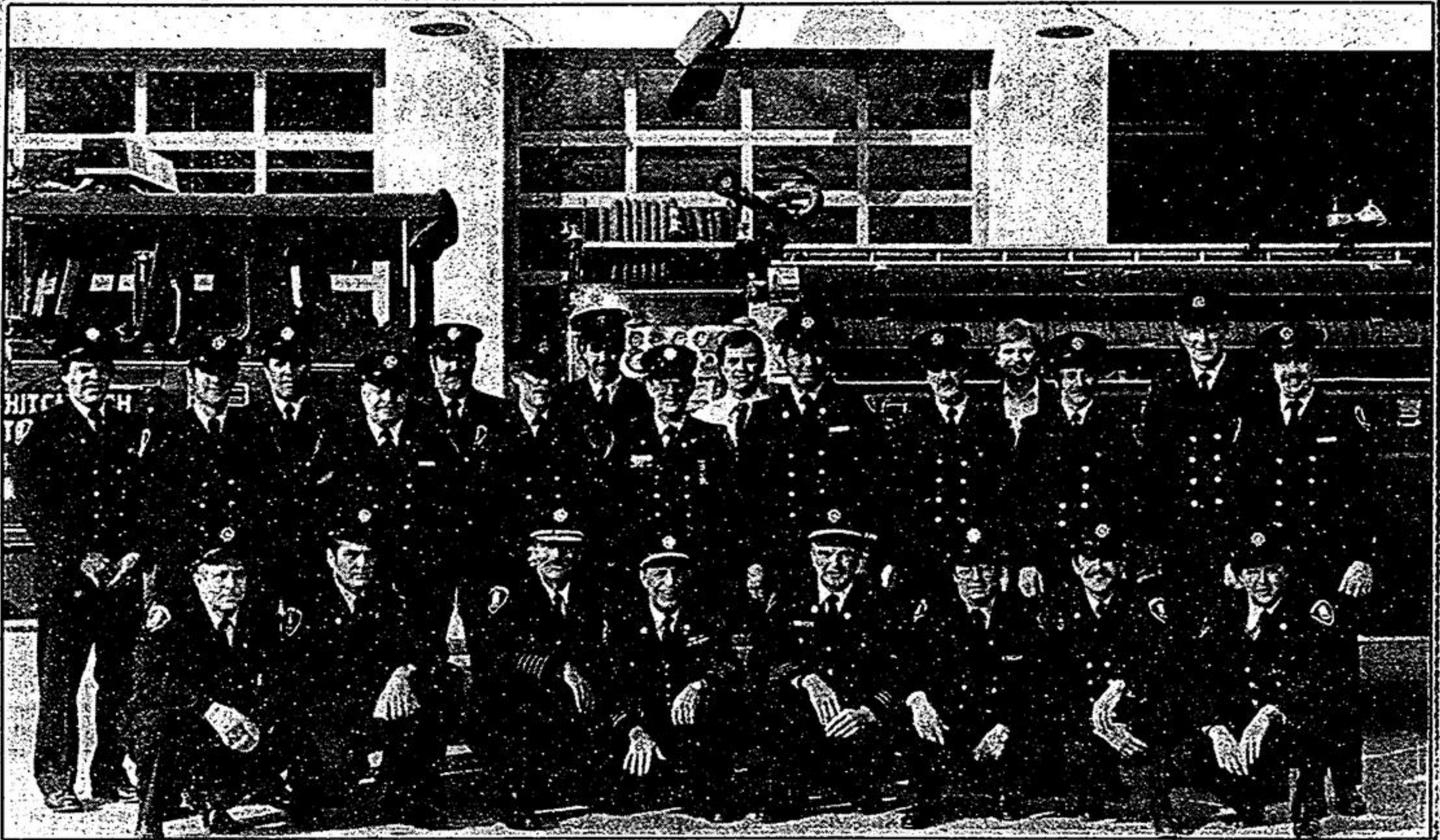
Dear Editor:

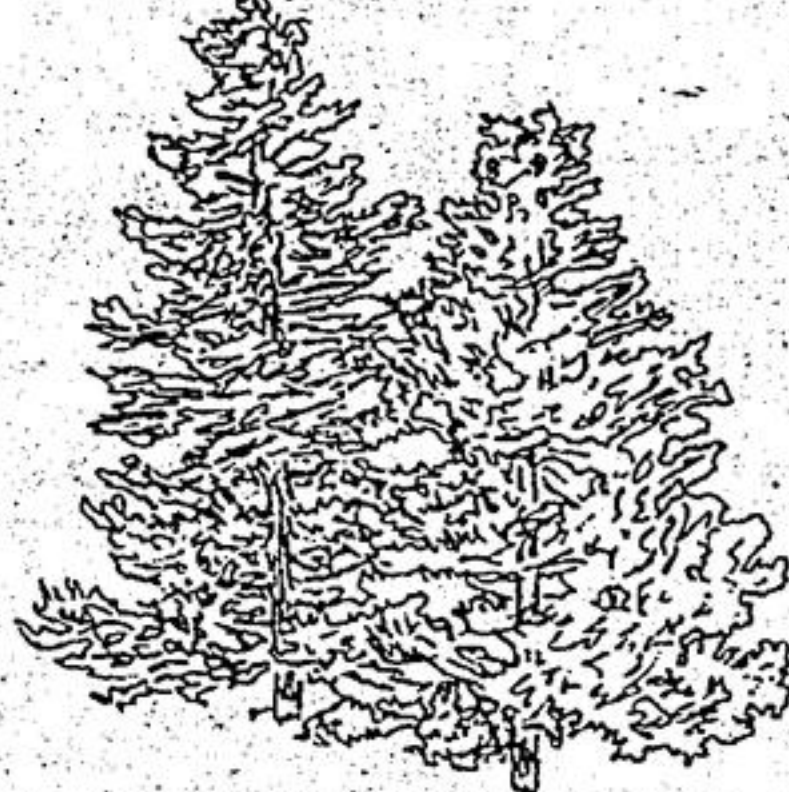
