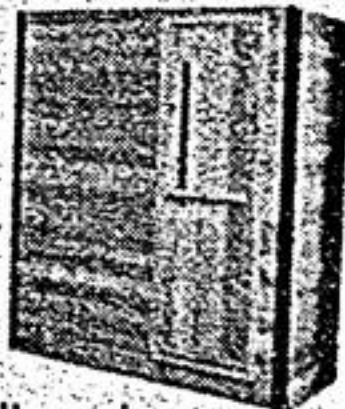

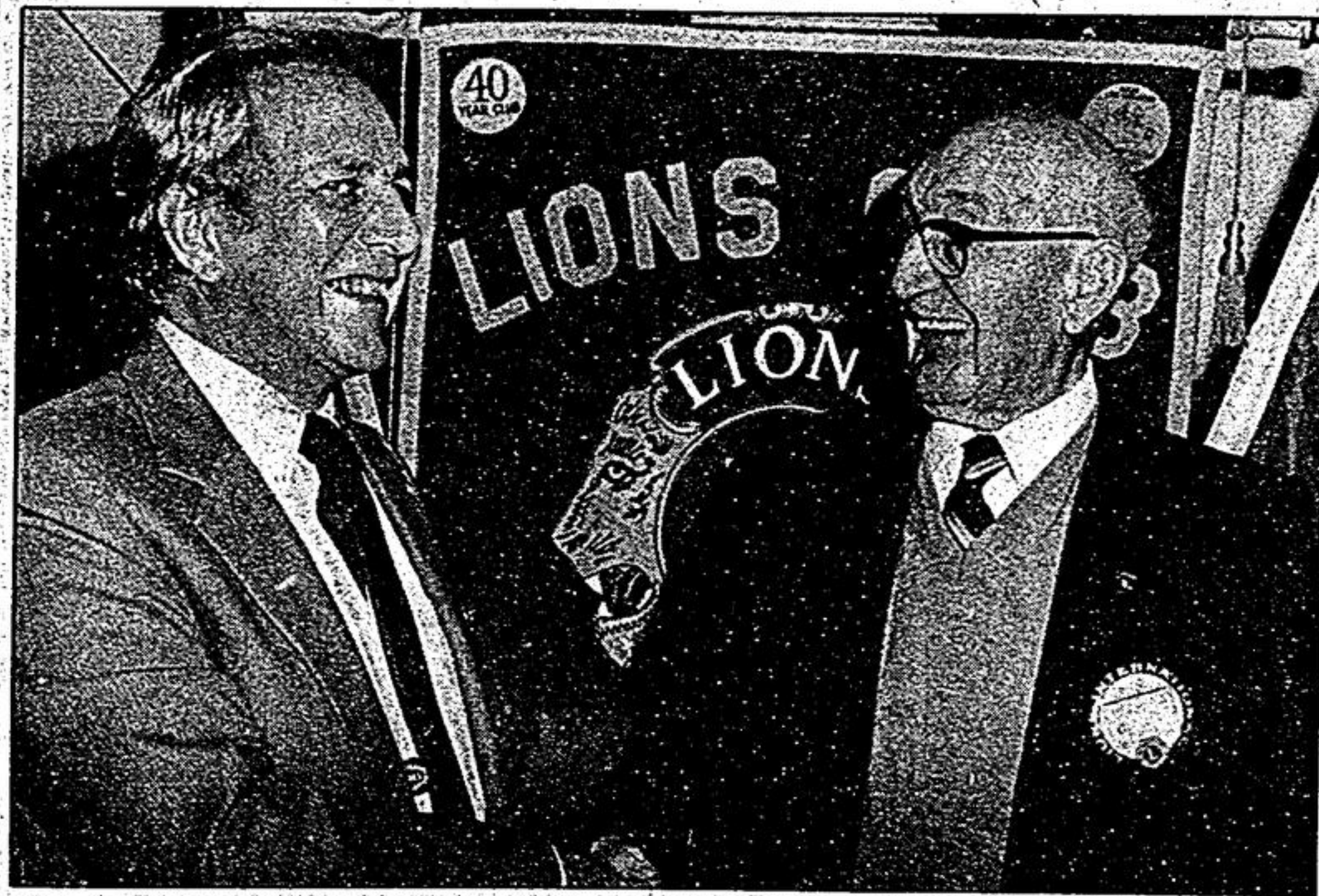

UXBRIDGE — On Friday, Oct. 3, 1986, Willis John Jarvis passed away in Uxbridge Cottage Hospital. He was 76.

Born at Armadale, Dec. 21, 1909, he was the son of John and Mary (Underwood) Jarvis.

On March 31, 1937, he married Pearl May Thaxter and lived for three years on the home farm. In 1940, they moved to Blackwater, then purchased a farm on the 3rd Concession of Brock Township where they remained until 1957. They then moved to Uxbridge.

Mr. Jarvis is sadly missed by his wife and two daughters, Evelyn and Donald Perry of Belleville; Thelma and Guy Cole of Queensville; one grandson, Dale and Sharilyn Perry of Ajax and four granddaughters, Sandra and Russell Jeffrey, Peterborough; Donna Perry and Teresa and Darlene Cole; and one great-granddaughter, Amanda Nicole Perry.

Mr. Gray always dreamed of 'graduating' his craft from Mud Lake to Musselman's Lake. But his dream was never realized. He was taken ill with cancer two years ago and died Oct. 31 in Sunnybrook Medical Centre. He was 57.

Born in Toronto, the son of Robert and Ann Gray, Jim moved to the Lake community in 1951.

He was greatly admired for his courage. Even while his health declined, he never lost hope of being well again.
