**Sabiston area**

**Residents pay full price for sewers**

Sabiston area residents will have to pay the full cost of sewers in their subdivision and still pay increased taxes for improved service.

Denise Ascenza, spokesperson for the Sabiston Subdivision Rate-payers Association, said residents who want sewers are willing to pay a portion of the cost, but the town told them each homeowner would be charged the total cost — \$17,000 or \$2,178 per year for 20 years — if the entire subdivision goes to sewers.

Although not all homeowners want to switch to sewers, Mrs. Ascenza said some of the residents are concerned about drainage with the new subdivision being built nearby. The group plans to meet with town engineers in December in the hope of reaching a compromise.

One benefit of the new subdivision is the town's plan to open a new access road west of Oakcrest Ave. At present, Oakcrest is the only route on to Hwy 7 and according to Mrs. Ascenza, it's been a continuous problem for residents.

However, it's a point of frustration that the town still has no plans to place a traffic light at the new access road.

"We need a traffic light to allow pedestrians to cross the highway," explained Mrs. Ascenza. "During rush hours in particular, you can sit for half an hour waiting to turn on to Hwy 7 from Oakcrest, and it's our only access."

She added that the only bus stop available to the area within reasonable walking distance is on the other side of the highway.

A number of students and working people take the bus every day crossing without a traffic light. Mrs. Ascenza is worried there will be another accident such as the one several years ago when a young blind boy was seriously injured and his seeing-eye dog killed.

On the subject of safety, Mrs. Ascenza also said residents object to the speed limit on Hwy 7 being 70 kph from the Unionville Bypass to Bullock Dr. while being 50 kph from Sciberras Rd. to Christman Court. They propose reducing the speed to be consistent along the busy stretch of highway.

The Sabiston Subdivision Rate-payers Association serves the community east and west of Oakcrest south of Hwy 7.
