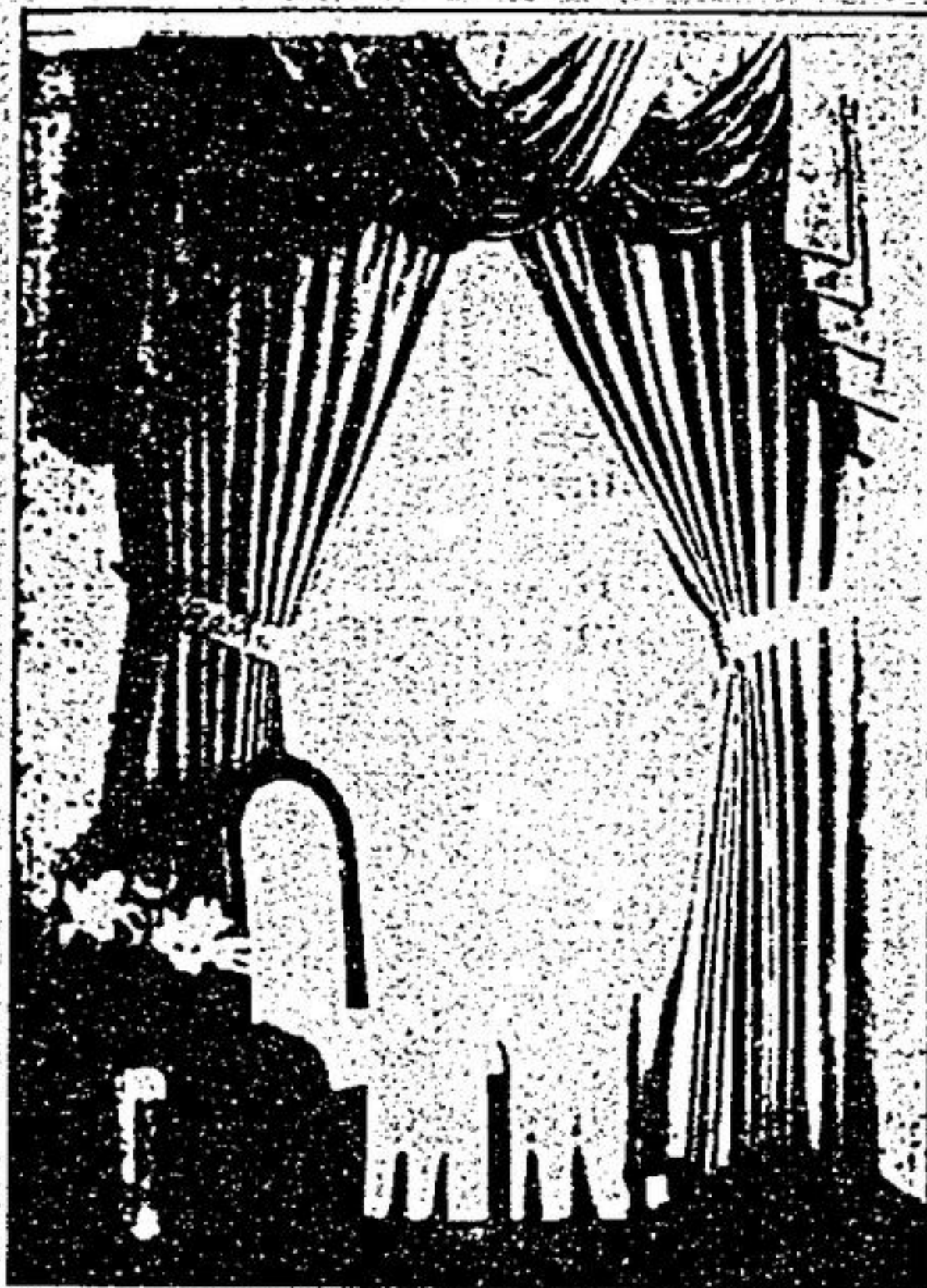

Vandals at school

Toronto and Regional Crime Stoppers and York Regional Police are seeking the assistance of the public in an effort to apprehend those responsible for damage to a school, and school buses.

Between Oct. 24th and 27th, person or persons unknown went to the area of Langstaff Secondary School, Garden Ave. in Richmond Hill. The suspect was in possession of either a pistol or rifle.

Suspect then proceeded to destroy five large windows in the school with two shots through each window. The suspect then went to the area where school buses were parked and continued to fire additional shots causing the following damage: Two buses had windshields, headlights, and side mirrors blown out. Total damage in this case exceeds \$3,000.
