the character of Renfield, the madman who feeds flies to spiders, Andrew Kirby contributed remarkable phrasing, stage presence and athleticism to his role. At 16, he's a young man to watch.

The entire cast exercised a firm control over their assumed accents — whether cockney, U English, Dutch or Transylvanian.

The set was a problem. Dispensing with two flanking country-house set pieces would have given us a better sense of place and added to the impact of the central Gothic backdrop. The placement of a sofa directly across the main upstage archway also robbed Dracula of some effective and dramatic entrances.

The castlelike setpiece really came into its own, however, in the final scene in the crypt, where sound, special effects and Nigel Edwards' lighting came together to create an atmosphere of spine-tingling eeriness. It was stunning.

Sound and lighting were excellent throughout, in fact, and the costumes, with one or two excep-

tions, were attractive and appropriate.

Androcles and the Lion is the charming tale of the Roman slave who befriends a lion and is later spared a grisly end, through gratitude, when the two confront each other in the arena.

This version was delightful. Done in commedia dell'arte style, with its emphasis on improvisations and interchanges with the audience, it was an ideal vehicle for the student actors. The colorful Renaissance costumes sparkled, and the Gothic set piece, doing double duty, worked well here, allowing for lots of comic exits and entrances, bumping into and peerings around. The musical arrangements of Bob Leonard and Bill Thomas contributed some very funny exchanges between the actors and trumpet fanfares.

The sheer exuberance and energy of the cast showed how much they were enjoying themselves and made one wish again that Dracula had been given comic treatment.

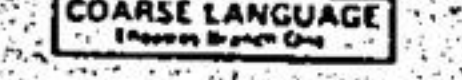
