

Restaurant planned with old-time "class"

The old Hagerman's Corners schoolhouse has a new role to play.

Markham planning committee last week approved an application to renovate and convert the old 14th Ave. structure into a restaurant while highlighting its historical design.

The plan had been sent back for revisions by members but was accepted as planned by the Riseborough Subcommittee in August and recently approved at a public meeting.

"It think it's a great idea," said Regional Councillor Bud Bonner of the plan. "It's a way of preserv-

ing the old building while making the building and land a useful part of the area."

Similar in concept to the successful Devonsleigh House at Steeles and Warden Aves., the plan calls for a large glass paneled addition to be built adjoining the rear of the school.

Soft-colored brick on the addition will offset and highlight the original structure also, according to a planning report.

"If they do the same thing with the Hagerman Schoolhouse (as with Devonsleigh House) it'll be great," said Councillor Bonner.

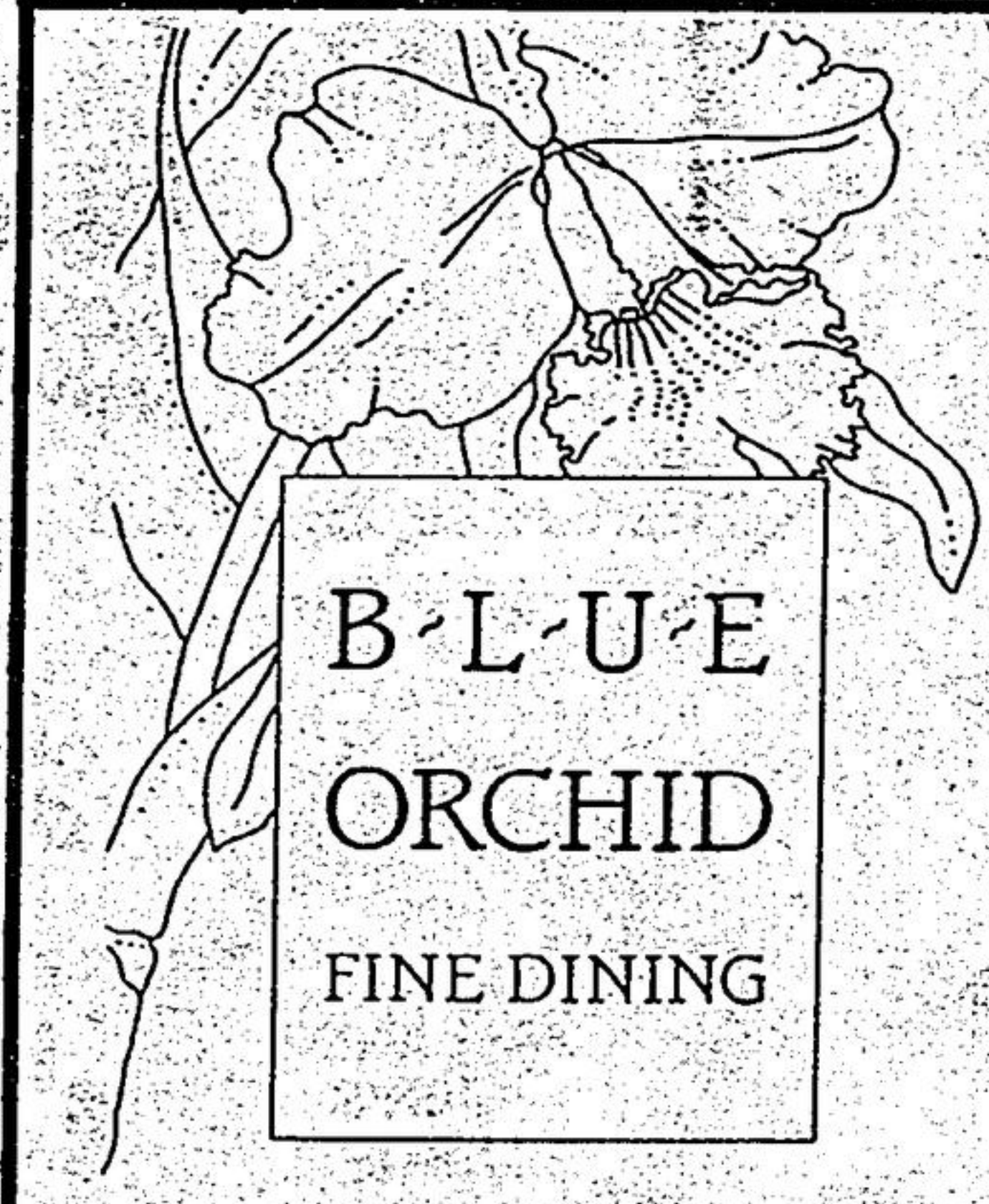
