

Changing streetscape

Main St. facelift planned in 1987

Next year, at this time, you will notice that Markham's Main Street will have had a face lift.

Work will begin next Spring on several major street improvements. All hydro wires and telephone cables will be buried, interlocking brick crosswalks and boulevards will be added, along with a new lighting system and small parklets.

The street improvement project encompasses not only the Town of Markham, but the Ministry of Transportation and Communications (Main St. is also a provincial highway) and Markham Hydro.

Ted Pickering, from Green Design in Markham, represents Markham's BIA on the subcommittee working on this project. Councillor Gord Landon heads the

12-member committee, with representatives from Markham Hydro, Markham Parks and Recreation and the town's Engineering Department.

"We would also like to remove the existing trees along the Main Street," explained Ted Pickering, of Green Design. "It would be easier for all services involved, when they begin to bury wires. We would replace the present trees with those that are suitable to hang white lighting up year-round."

Mr. Pickering explained that Markham does not sell its Main Street as an historic village, but needs to improve facilities for shoppers and visitors.

"Main St. is a practical place for residents to shop, but needs its outward image improved," said Mr. Pickering.
