

Newsletter keeps voters in touch

UXBRIDGE TWP. — When seeking election to the position of Councillor in Ward 1, Uxbridge Twp. candidate Cal Avery promised publication of a newsletter covering accomplishments dur-

ing the year. This he has done. Many are being delivered personally this week while other copies are available in the Goodwood General

Store and Post Office. Councillor Avery is, for the most part, pleased with what he's been able to accomplish in Ward 1. He admits, however, to dis-

appointments, particularly in the area of safeguarding intersections.

Councillor Avery sees the corner of Hwy. 47 and the Blooming-

ton Road, (Lincolntonville), as a potential death trap. The painting of lines-only is not enough, he says. "I will continue to fight for traffic lights in this dangerous area," he states.

He also wants a flashing light installed at the intersection of Hwy. 47 and Durham Road 21, (formerly Hwy. 1A), at Goodwood.

"The provincial requirements," says Avery, "seem to place deaths and accident numbers above potential hazardous situations."

On the positive side, Councillor Avery is pleased that flower planters were located in Goodwood for a first time. Maintenance was done by the residents.

Goodwood will be appropriately decorated for the Christmas season.

Councillor Avery has voiced opposition to strip residential development in the rural area. Instead, he's supportive of growth in the hamlets.

"The township is on the move," he says. "I hope to help preserve some of the rural setting and atmosphere. I will fight severances that are not in our best interests."

Although GO-Transit rejected a bus shelter in Goodwood, the Council is undertaking this project on its own, Avery reveals. Work will be completed on Conc. 3 between Hwy. 47 and Durham Road 21.

Councillor Avery is also anxious to complete house-numbering in Goodwood.

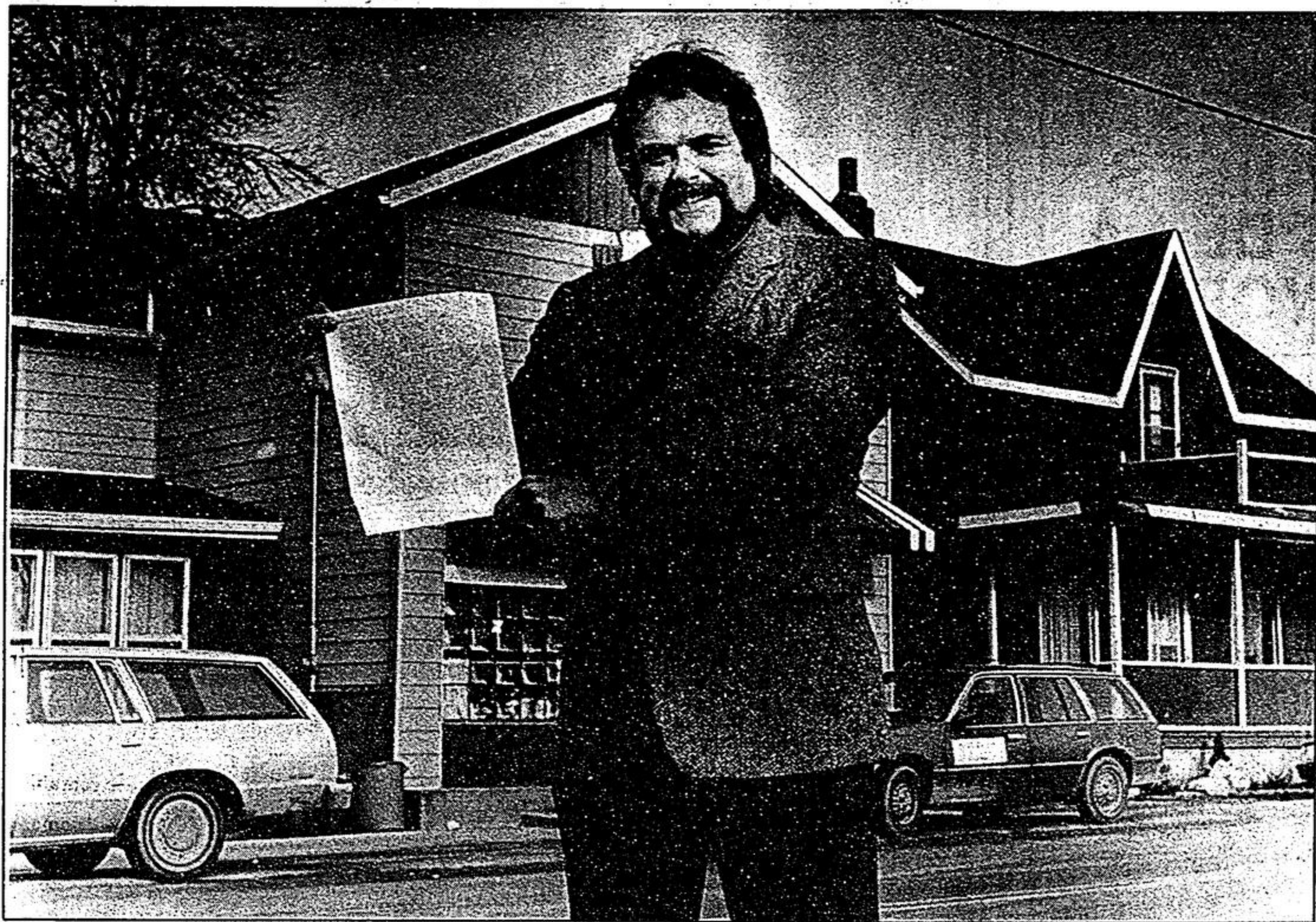
In the rural part of Ward 1, Mr. Avery has promised a 'blend' of industrial land that will provide employment for young people and much-needed tax revenue. At the same time, he wants to keep the township "a desirable place in which to live and visit."

Councillor Avery favors oil on gravel roads as opposed to calcium.

He wants a 'Welcome to Glasgow' sign erected as requested by the residents of that hamlet.

He predicts continued planned growth in the community of Copps Corners.

Councillor Avery sees Ward 1 as being rich in gravel deposits and predicts gravel mining will continue some time into the future. With this in mind, he warns potential property purchasers to look at sites carefully before buying.
