## Deer Park Inn is sold to local real estate man

Prominent Stouffville businessman John Whytall has increased his local interests by purchasing the Deer Park Inn.

Mr. Whytall, owner of Stouffville's Country Tyme Realty Ltd. and Country Club Donuts, will take over the Hwy 47 dinner theatre in March.

Although his plans are not finalized, Mr. Whytall said he intends to move the Country Tyme Realty offices to the Hwy 47 location.

However, he stressed the restaurant, banquet facilities and dinner theatre will remain open. Mr. Whytall also plans to convert an on-site apartment into an exclusive fitness centre for area businessmen.

"Changes have to be made slowly if there's going to be any changes," he said. "There will be some renovations, but it will basically remain the same. We'll have more definite plans by the end of February."

Deer Park Inn sits on 10 acres of land just north of the Stouffville Sales Barn. The building is 17,000 square feet in size.

Present owner Eric Farrell is the original owner of Deer Park

Inn which has been a successful enterprise both from the theatre and restaurant aspect hosting a wide range of people including bus loads from Toronto.

Deer Park is also a popular spot for meetings of local service clubs and wedding receptions.

Gustavo Galluzzi has been named president and general manager of American Express Canada Inc.



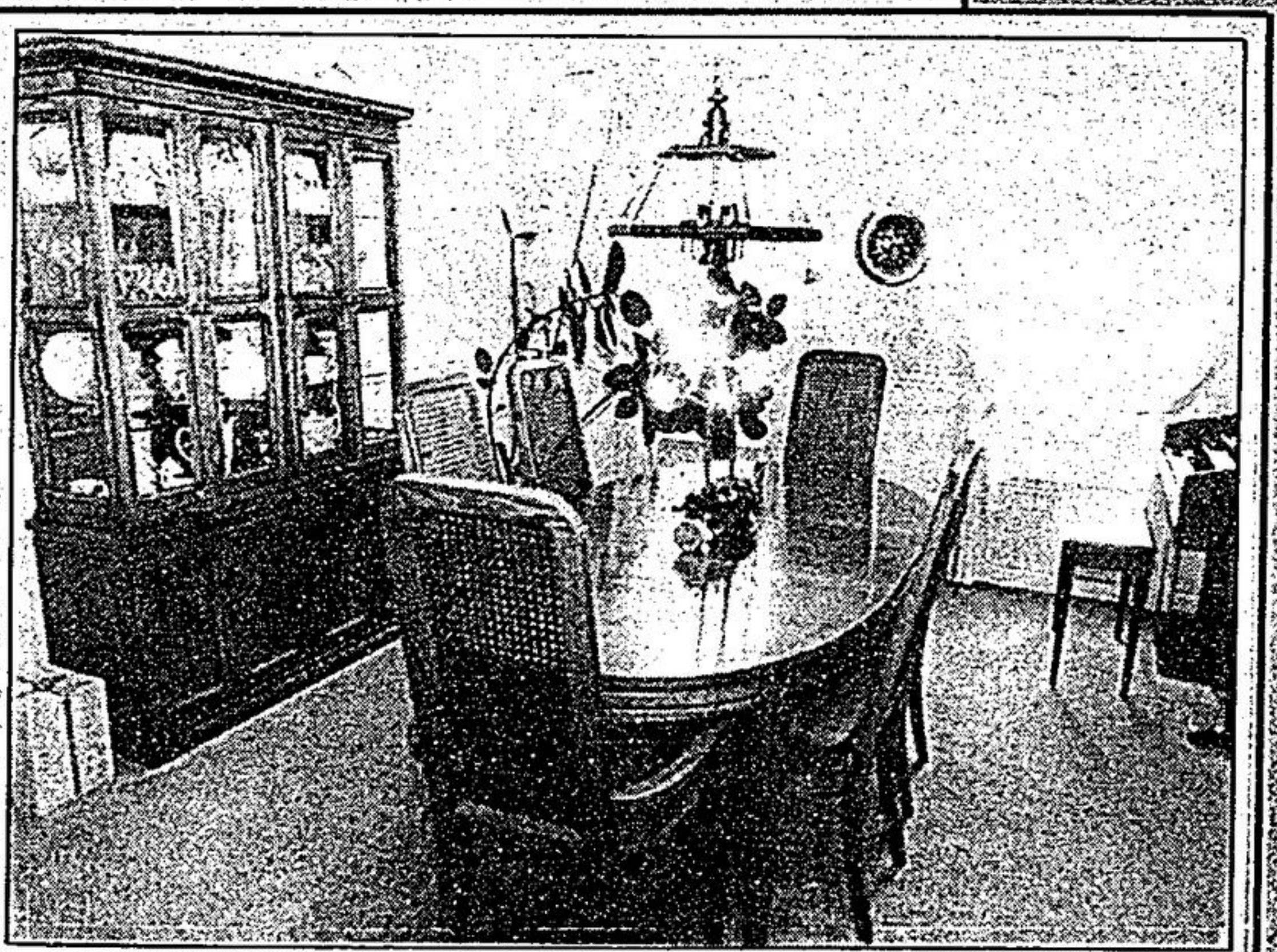
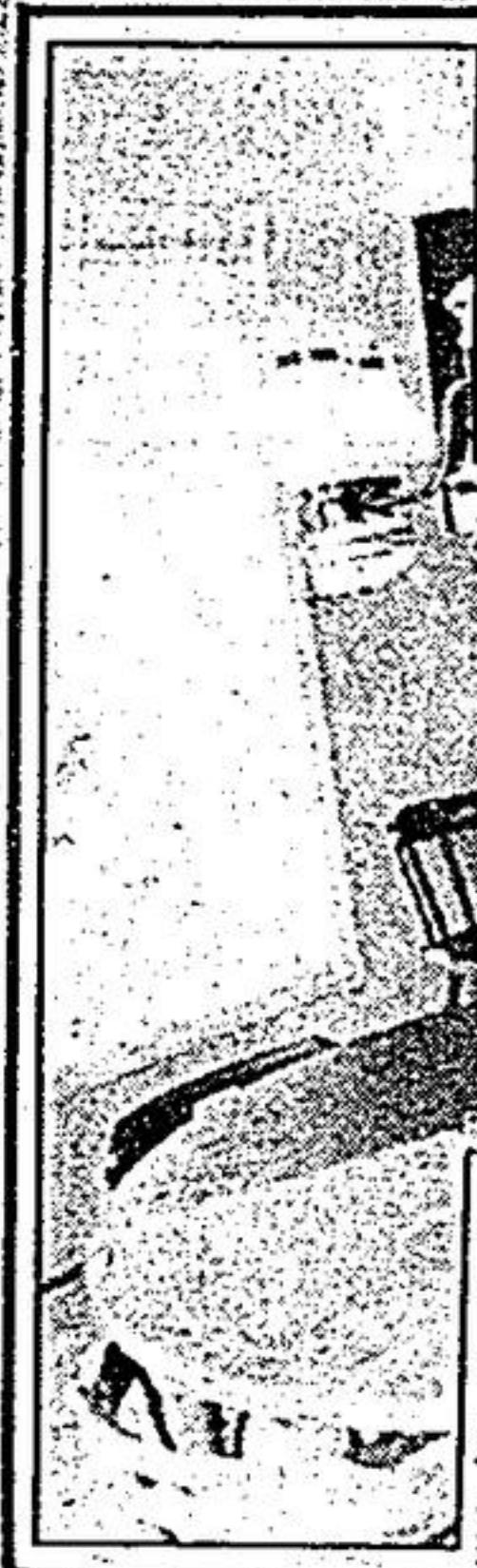
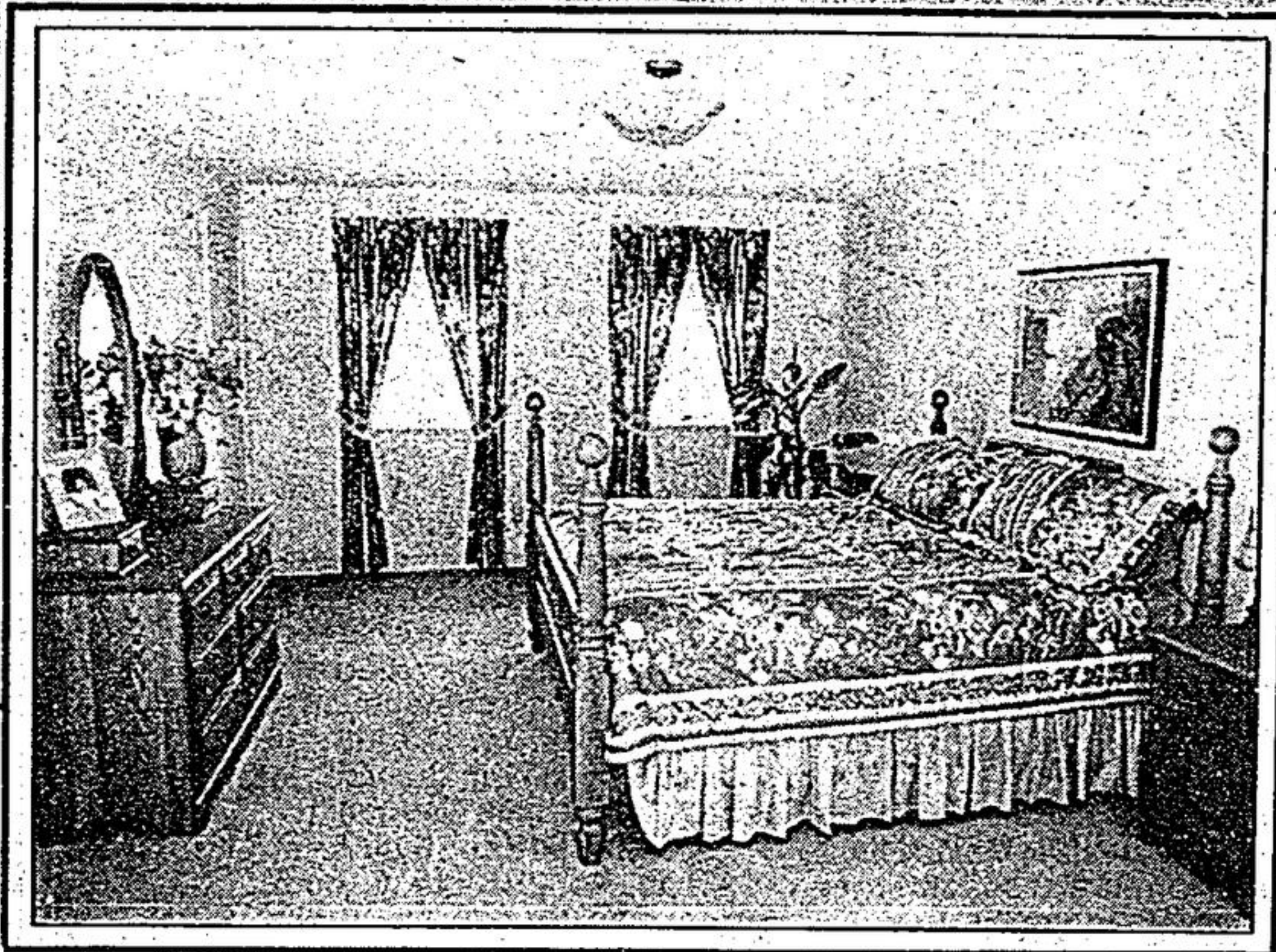
