During the entire 13-week training period, the youths will receive a weekly training allowance.

Class size is very limited to ensure a more successful teacher-student interaction. The students will be trained on typing, office procedures, life & work skills and job-search techniques, plus word processing on Wang and IBM professional computers.

After the training, the youths will be placed in various businesses and companies for another 13 week of on-the-job practical work experience.
