

Residents offered a chance to carry the Olympic torch

Households across the country will soon receive a brochure outlining how citizens can participate in Canada's Olympic Torch Relay.

A mailing campaign, possibly the largest in Canadian postal history, began yesterday. The pamphlets include an official application form for interested torchbearers.

The Olympic flame leaves from St. John's, Nfld., Nov. 17, 1987, and continues on an 88-day, 18,000 km journey that passes through Markham, Whitchurch-Stouffville and Pickering Dec. 21-23.

It arrives at its final destination — the XV Olympic Winter Games in Calgary, Alta., — on Feb. 13, 1988.

"The Olympic Torch Relay belongs to every Canadian and as such, all Canadians, including mentally or physically challenged people, have an opportunity to participate," said information contained in a *Share the Flame* booklet.

"It will be the kind of experience you'll never forget; a living souvenir of Canada's first-ever Olympic Winter Games.

"If you're capable of carrying the 1.5 kilogram torch one kilometre, apply by March 31, 1987, for your chance to participate."

Additional application forms are available at the following Relay Application Centres: participating Petro-Canada service sta-

tions; Petro-Canada-branded bulk sales associates across Canada, as well as Gulf-branded service stations or bulk sales associates in Ontario and western Canada. A maximum of five forms will be given out per visit.

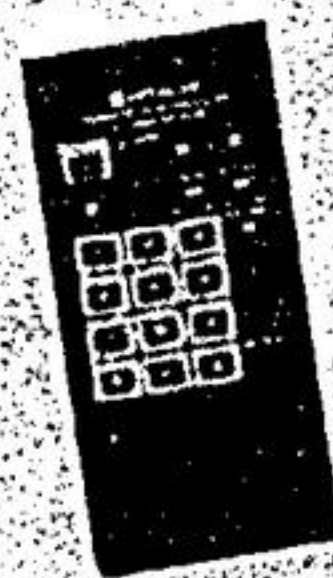
