


Help coping with stress from new holistic therapy centre in Altona

A holistic approach is the key to prolonged well-being and general good health, say the operators of a therapy centre near Stouffville. Stress management is one of the important elements stressed at The Integrative Therapy Centre, which opened last September in the Altona home of health care therapist Diane Kerr.

"Primarily this is a growth centre and the aim is to help people have a better quality of life," according to Mrs. Kerr, who launched the project with colleagues Jill Lepard and Marty Meshberg.

Programs are available in everything from reflexology, massage and psychotherapy, to various specialized group or private sessions involving professional consultants. Children's drama and child enrichment programs are examples of upcoming offerings at the country centre.

The therapists don't diagnose but they will refer a person to a doctor if they feel it's necessary for health reasons.

"We're not replacing doctors, we're working in collaboration with them," explained Mrs. Kerr, a group animation therapist with more than 10 years of experience in the field.

Most of the centre's clientele,

including many residents of the Markham and Metro Toronto area, have been attracted to the Altona facility by word of mouth.

Mrs. Kerr, who formerly operated out of a Stouffville location, said her therapy centre proposal had been on the back burner for about 10 years.

"I've been waiting to do it for years but I didn't have the location," she noted.

Now that her dream has come true, she stressed that she and her partners are thoroughly enjoying their role as holistic health healers.
