Development is booming

Uxbridge's urban area appears to be on the verge of a residential building boom following a flood of development proposals in 1986. Last year was one of the planning and development committee's busiest years for proposals, explained Township Clerk Walter Taylor.
 Probably the highest profile of all these is Quaker Village, a fully-serviced housing development slated for acreage fronting the north side of Brock St. West, near Uxbridge Arena. A series of model homes have been erected on site, with work on Seaton Group/Foxbridge Corporation's 86-lot first phase expected to begin as soon as a subdivision agreement is finalized.
 Other planned urban development includes a condominium on the south side of Brock Street, across from Quaker Village. Sagebrook Investments Limited of Toronto plans a total of 62 garden homes and townhouses on a 6.7-acre property.
 Also on Uxbridge's planning books is a proposal for a three-storey apartment building featuring 30 one-bedroom suites. Ron Fisco has targeted that building for a site on Main St. North (Conc.7).
 Whichurch-Stouffville resident Gino Testa is attempting to gain the green light for a 43-lot fourth phase of his Testa Heights subdivision in southeast Uxbridge. Meanwhile, an apartment proposal for Mr. Testa's neighboring industrially-zoned parcel is on hold pending the completion of Uxbridge Township's Secondary Plan (a guide for future residential, industrial and commercial growth in Uxbridge's urban area).
 According to Mr. Taylor, a major residential development is also in the works for lands adjacent to Uxbridge Cottage Hospital. While there has yet to be official application, the clerk said plans have been formalized by a development group which includes Stouffville real estate investor Ken May.
