

# Unionville OMHA Results

## Injuries do in Exco

Injuries played a key factor in knocking out the Exco Engineering Peewees from the championship round of a Belleville tournament last weekend.

Unionville went undefeated in three consecutive games to gain a spot in the semi-finals. It opened with a 5-5 tie against Oshawa.

Mike Byblow scored 2 and Andrew Watts, Jamie Burton and Todd Rappitt added singles. Assists went to Ted Wyborn (2), Burton (2), Watts, Greg Pipher, Rick Cleland, Kevin Miller and David Lightfoot.

Led by Byblow's hat trick, the Jets dumped Belleville 6-2 in the second outing. Goals went to Miller (2), Lightfoot and Byblow (3). Notching assists were Byblow, Lightfoot, Miller, Rappitt, Cleland and Burton.

Unionville won the round-robin with a 5-2 victory over Mississauga. Dave Carlisle (2), Miller, Wyborn and Pipher handled the offence. Watts, Wyborn, Burton (2) and Cleland assisted.

But in the semi-finals Unionville was forced to go with only 10 skaters because of injuries. And the lack of manpower showed in the final score, a 7-2 loss to Milton. Byblow and Carlisle scored.

The boys headed into the final consolation round still with five players missing, and despite a gallant effort lost 5-3 to North Bay.

Carlisle — named MVP of the 16-team, three-day tourney — netted a pair of goals and Burton added a single. Pipher and Miller had two assists each.
