Golf tourney tickets now on sale

Summer is almost here, and with it comes the third annual Markham Stouffville Hospital Golf Tournament.

Tickets are now on sale for the event, which is Friday, Aug. 21 at Stouffville's Sleepy Hollow Golf and Country Club. The Economist & Sun/Tribune co-sponsors it with the Canadian Tire stores in Markham and Stouffville.

Entry is \$100 per golfer (unchanged from last year), and includes the golf, a buffet dinner, loads of prizes and a slide show of the day's shenanigans on the course.

Only 144 tickets are available, as well as 30 dinner-only tickets at \$40 apiece. So far, the tournament has raised almost \$30,000 for the hospital, now being built on the 9th line just north of Hwy 7.

The fund-raising includes hole sponsorships at \$300 each, and that entire amount is tax deductible.
