Home in 1986. She and husband Norm are the parents of three and the grandparents of four. She's a member in the congregation of Springvale Baptist Church.

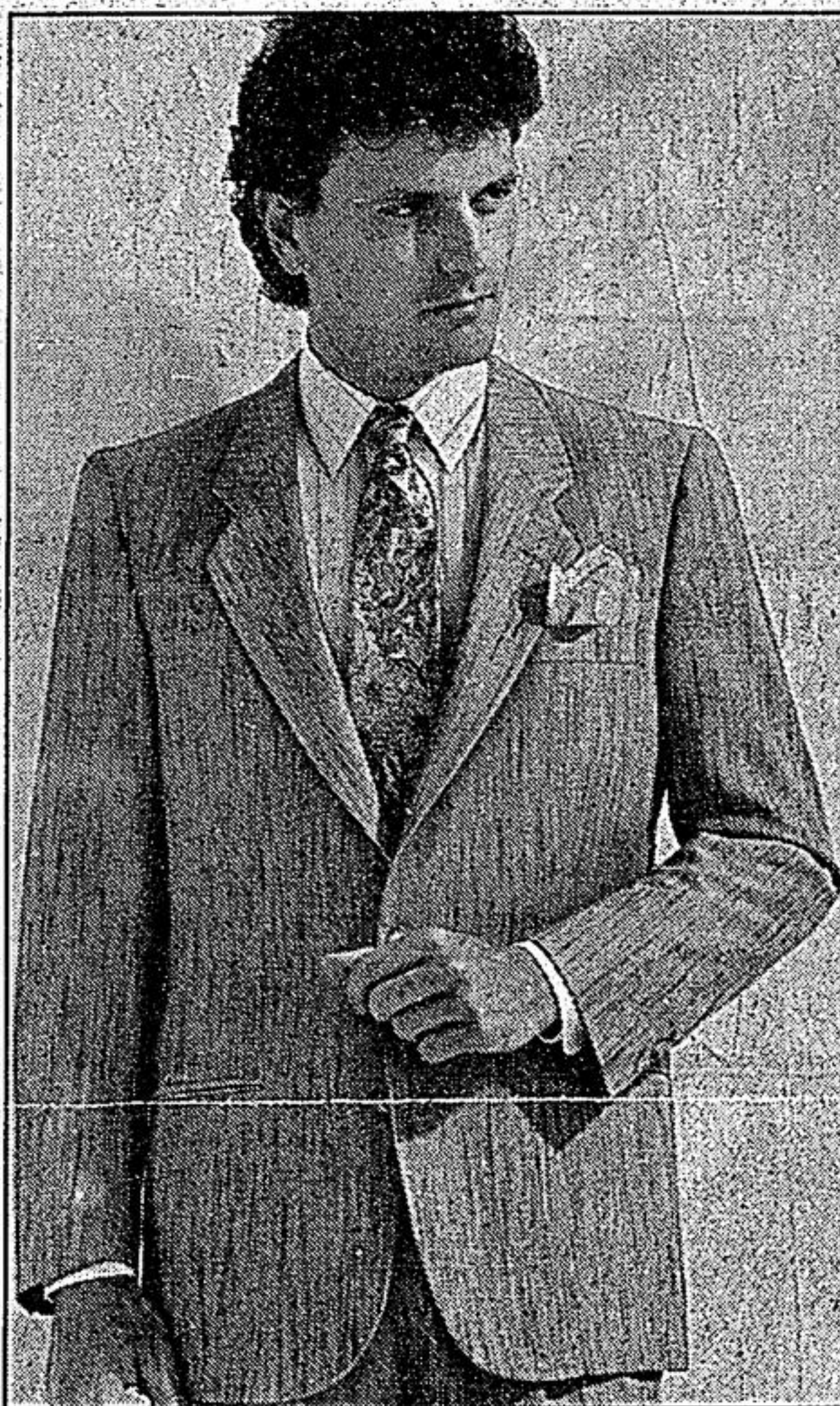
