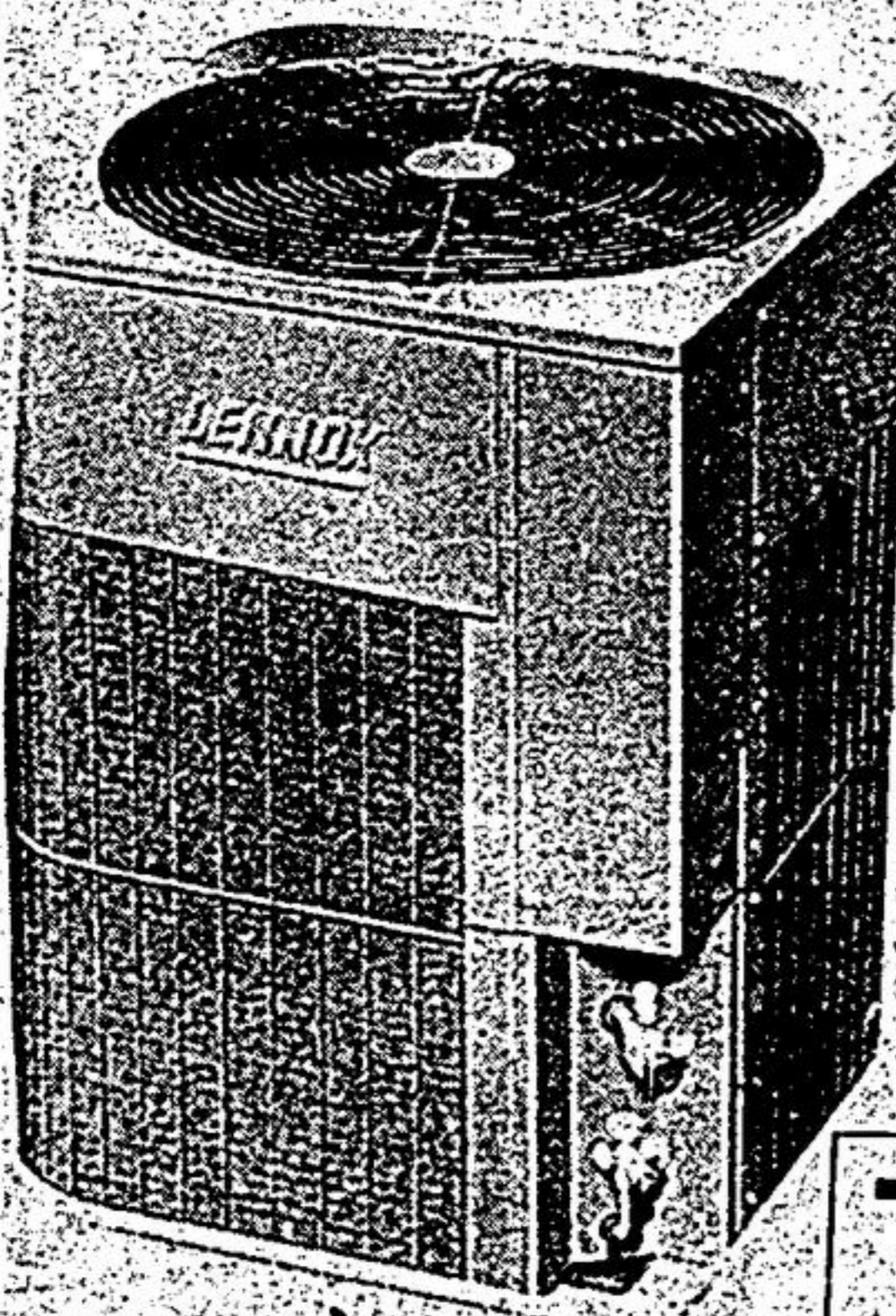
**Boogie back to the 1950s
