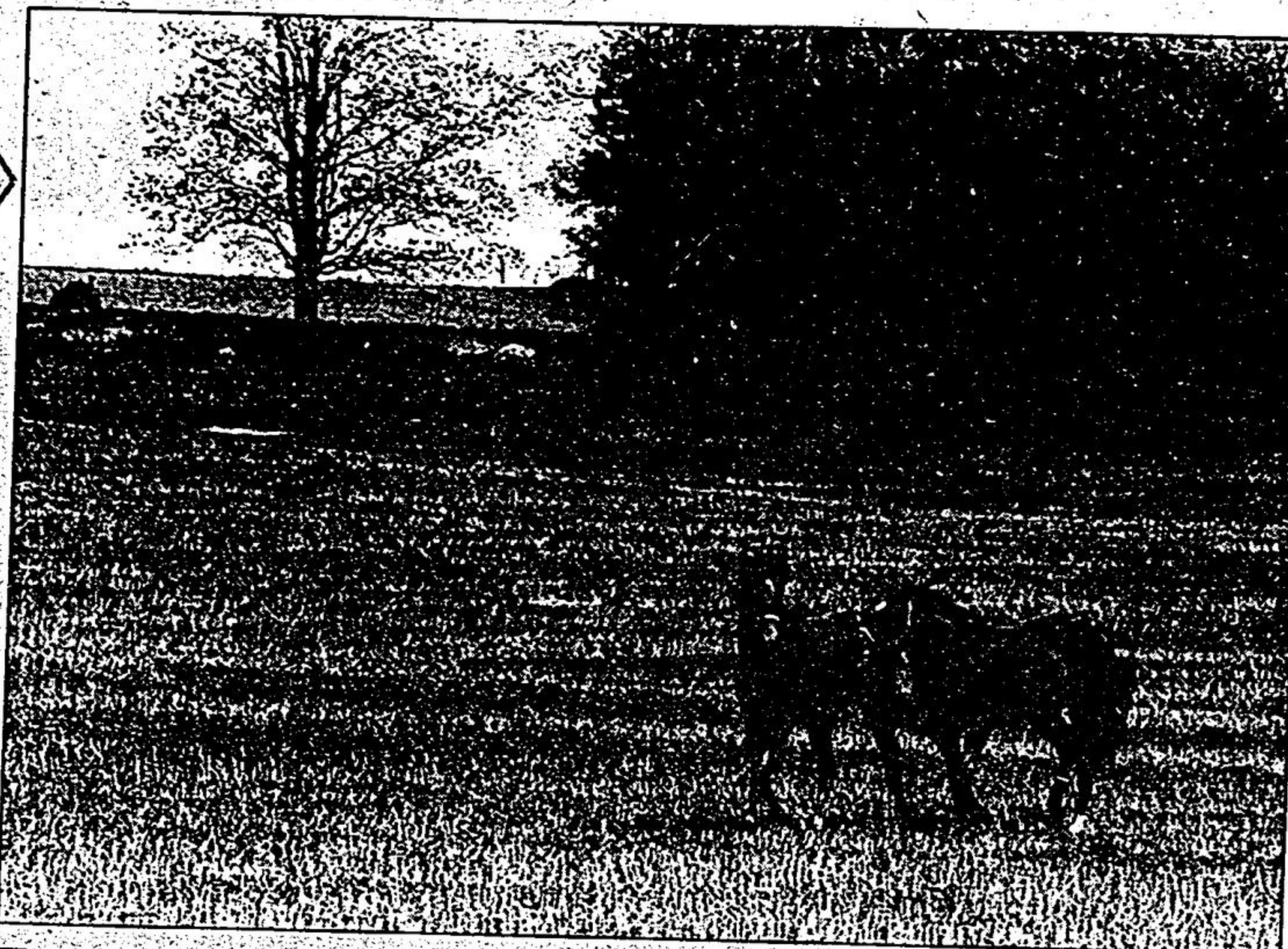

0092. Information on the run will soon be available. Watch for announcements in the Economist and Sun.

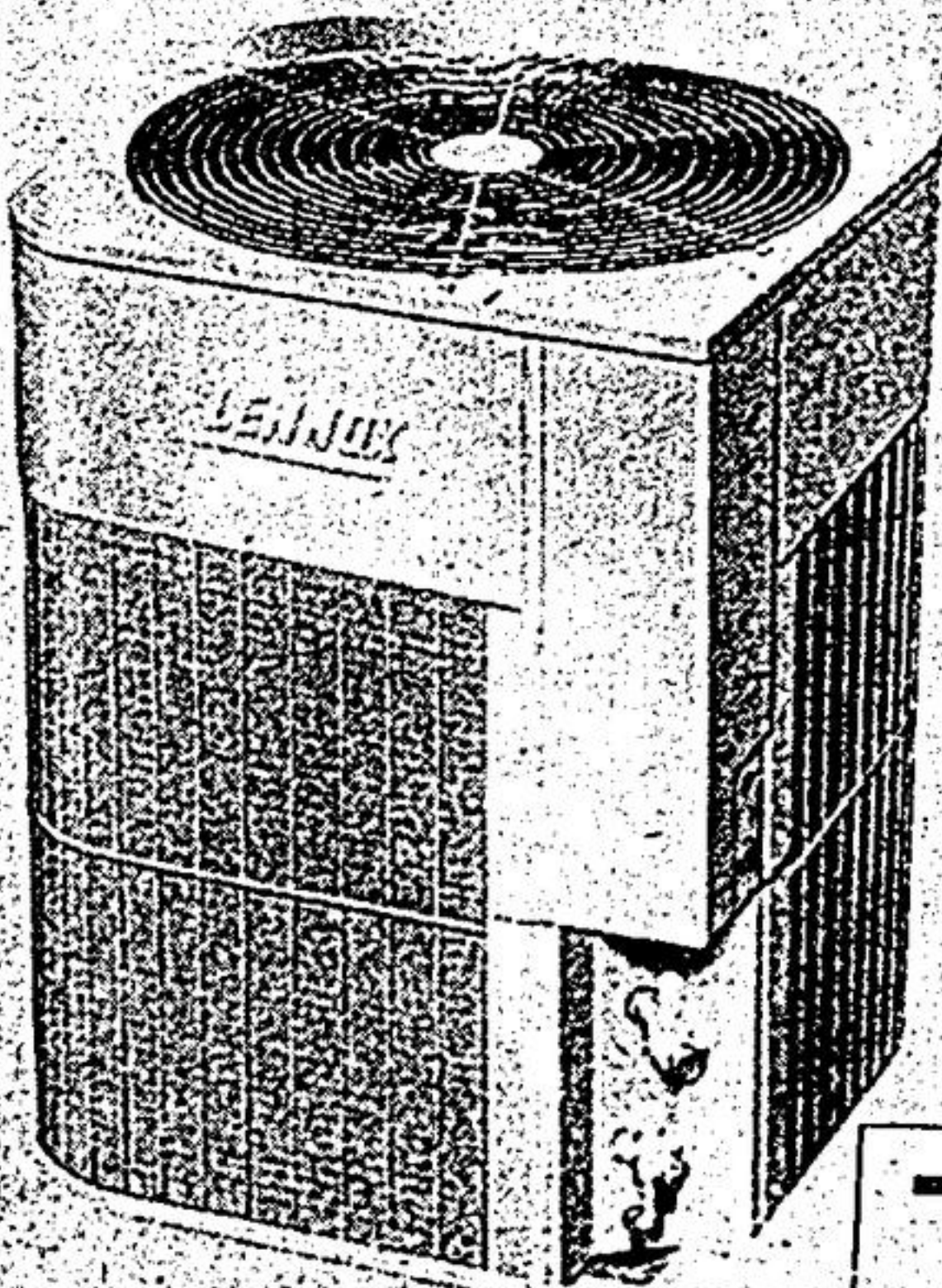
Planning for the 1987 parade, which kicks off the festival Saturday at 10 a.m., is in the advanced stages.
