The dedication of a woman who was not a mother herself led to the 1914 U.S. proclamation and later, a widespread observance of Mother's Day. Anna Reeves Jarvis, a Philadelphian, decided shortly after the death of her much beloved mother to promote the designation of a special day to honor mothers. Beginning with local church services, the observance of Mother's Day caught on quickly and soon became the "queen for a day" occasion we now celebrate.

Anna Jarvis suggested the carnation as the symbol for Mother's Day. It is represented on cards for the occasion to this day. According to Jarvis' suggestion, a white carnation is worn in memory of a dead mother and a red one is worn in honour of a living mother.
