

Thirty years and four stores later, the Longo family is coming into its own.

Preparing for a June opening in Markham, Longo's Food Market sees the move as a coup for food retailers.

"Markham is an expanding market," says Anthony Longo, a junior family member of the 30-year-old business. "The growth rate we've seen shows that Markham is the second fastest growing city in Markham."

With an emphasis on fresh produce — about 60 per cent of its stock — store officials are confident they can claim a percentage of local shoppers.

Built within sight of competing food retail store Knob Hill farms on Hwy 7, Mr. Longo said the two will draw shopping traffic from one another.

But there isn't a concern about

direct competition between the two.

Mr. Longo said the produce focus will appeal to a different clientele.

"We feel we're in two different markets," he said Thursday. "The average grocery store has about 10 to 15 per cent (designated for produce)."

And that emphasis is the cornerstone of the growing Longo chain. Started on Toronto's Yonge St. by brothers Tom, Gus and Joe in the 50s, the policy hasn't changed.

"We've always had that focus," noted Mr. Longo. "It's only been in the last six years we've really expanded into grocery, deli and fresh meat."

The grand opening of Markham's first store, which was three years in the making, is June 3.
