

Miracle gets an 'ultra' makeover

When the Markville Shopping Centre's Miracle Food Mart (5000 Highway 7) opens its doors Thursday, May 14, it will sport a new name — Miracle Ultra-Mart — plus a totally new look.

Miracle Ultra-Mart stores provide one-stop, round-the-clock grocery shopping with more than a dozen specialty departments — plus a full-range pharmacy staffed by licensed pharmacists for the dispensing of prescriptions.

The new Markville Miracle, which has been in this location since the shopping centre opened six years ago, will celebrate that completion of its six-month-long refurbishing construction project with opening ceremonies that include free refreshments and family fun for all its customers.

The ceremonies will be set in motion on the 14th by Markham's Mayor Carole Bell cutting the ribbon at 10 a.m., while popular CFTO-TV weatherman Dave Devall acts as Master of Ceremonies. Throughout the day there will be live remotes with CKEY Radio broadcasting on location.

A Dixieland band will entertain shoppers from 9:30 a.m. until noon, and each customer will be presented with a carnation

(while quantities last). Complimentary coffee and cake will be served all day, and there will be a variety of interesting in-store cooking demonstrations and foods to sample.

In addition, clowns will be doing balloon tricks from 4 to 8 p.m. on both Thursday and Friday, as well as wandering throughout the store to entertain children and give them balloons.

On Saturday, May 16, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., the clowns will be back at their tricks again, but this time they will be doing children's face painting also.

In addition to the pharmacy, there are separate departments for health and beauty aids and baby care products.

All specialty food sections, such as the bulk food area, have been expanded and refurbished. The fresh fish market now sells home-made chowder, and will even custom-steam shellfish for its customers; the Deli offers a useful party-planning program; the Tudor Bakery features fresh, hot bread, baked right on the premises; the butcher's shop specialty is fresh, store-made sausage; two whole aisles are given over to multi-cultural foods and recipe ingredients; and the fruit and

vegetable market boasts every quality produce item available at any given time, including the specialty vegetables called for in many exotic international recipes.

Two new specialty sections are a soup and salad bar and a fresh flower and plant boutique.

The Markville Miracle Ultra-Mart is designed to be fully accessible to the handicapped. It will be open 24 hours a day from 9 a.m. Monday through 9 p.m. Saturday. The pharmacy will be open from 9 a.m. to midnight Monday through Friday, and from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. on Saturday.
