A special Salute to Faith is planned for June 21 at 11 a.m. A men's chorale will be ministering in song and a special book entitled Dads Only will be presented to each father present.

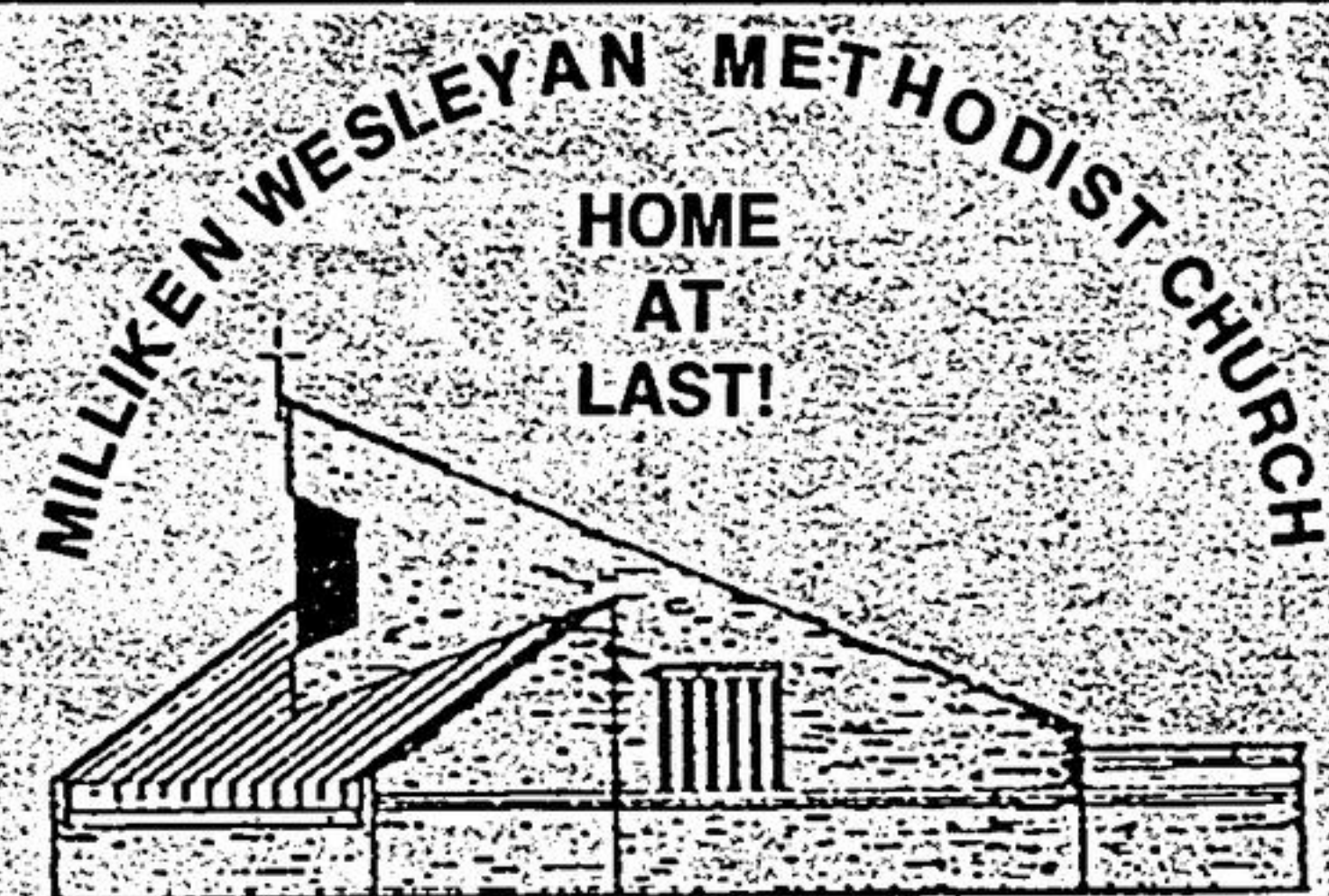
A program for boys and girls featuring the film series Sunshine Factory will run July 6 to July 10. Further details will be announced at a later date.

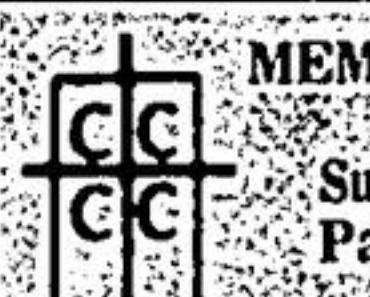
