## Town eyesores disappear

STOUFFVILLE — Four down, eight to go.

Eight is the number of 'eyesores' still awaiting clean-up in Whitchurch-Stouffville.

Mayor Fran Sainsbury says a year ago, there were at least a dozen industrial-commercial sites in dire need of improvement. This number, she says, has now been reduced to eight.

Mayor Sainsbury credits the Town's Property Standards By-law with bringing these changes about.

But action takes time, she admits.

With respect to the Industrial Park, extending west off Woodbine Avenue north of Gormley, Mrs. Sainsbury claims outside storage was permitted in the original agreement. The properties, however, are supposed to be properly landscaped, bermed and fenced, she explains.

Easier than the municipality lowering the boom, Mayor Sainsbury is confident the firms will eventually police one another. "All have a vested interest," she says.

## Committee praised

STOUFFVILLE — Work of the Strawberry Festival Committee has been praised by Town Council.

"A great job was done by everyone," said Councillor Wayne Ermerson at a meeting July 2.

Councillor Jim Sanders described the committee as "outstanding." He asked they be sent a letter of appreciation.

The number of spectators in the Park for the fireworks display, July 1 was estimated at over 5,000.

"Every time a 'big boomer' went up, my husband said, 'there goes another \$55,'" responded Councillor Margot Marshall.

### Cooking Tips

Heat in pan, 1 cup olive oil, 1 tbs. oregano 1 tbs. crushed bay leaf, juice of 1 lemon, 4 garlic cloves chopped fine, 2 tbs. dried basil, 1 tsp. celery salt, 1 tsp. black pepper, 1/2 cup melted butter. Melt above ingredients in pan. Place it in dish with steaks & marinate about 1 hour. Place on B.B.Q. approx 6 min. each side, basting each time you turn steaks.

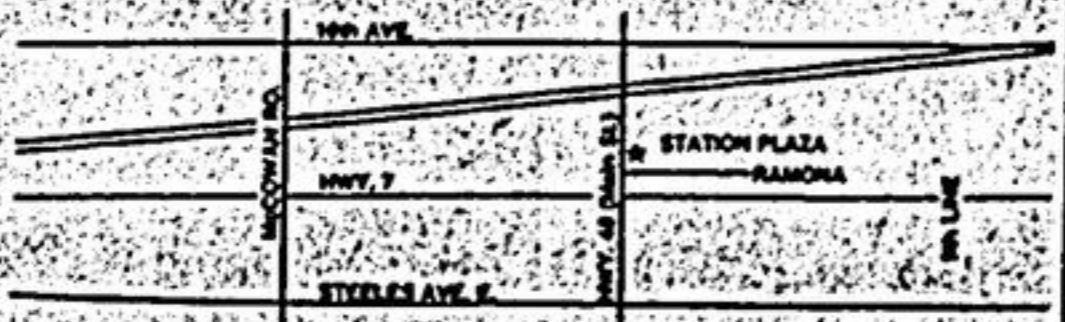
