Sheep are in focus at 10th show

MARKHAM — Sheep Focus marks its 10th anniversary this year, and Whitchurch-Stouffville's Lynn Westaway will play a big part in the celebrations.

The McCowan Rd. resident will conduct sheepdog clinics and demonstrations during the event at Markham Fairgrounds this Friday and Saturday (July 17 and 18).

The Ontario Sheep Marketing Agency's annual lamb, wool and sheep festival is not just for producers, as there's activities that people from all walks of life and from all ages will enjoy.

For the children, there'll be a balloon release contest, coloring activities and a craft corner where youngsters can work on a loom with wool to create something to take home. Each child will also receive a small bag of raw wool plus a souvenir ribbon.

Children can also see and touch the sheep in the barn and watch them in the show ring and being rounded up by sheep dogs.

For the post-coloring set, Sheep Focus offers craft workshops throughout both days where visitors can make sheep from carded wool, an angel from special Massam wool for the Christmas tree, or learn how to make a sheepskin rug.

On Saturday, there will be two fashion shows featuring Canadian wool clothing, some of which will be for sale, plus numerous opportunities to sample lamb dishes and learn how to prepare Ontario shepherd's favorite recipes. In attendance will be exhibitors from across the province selling hand-crafted items such as sweaters, sweater kits, vests, decorations, folk art and lots more.

There will also be educational displays, sheepdog demos and a shearing competition for both professionals and novices.

Cost of admission is \$3, with children under 12 free with one adult. Show hours are Friday from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m. and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Cooking Tips

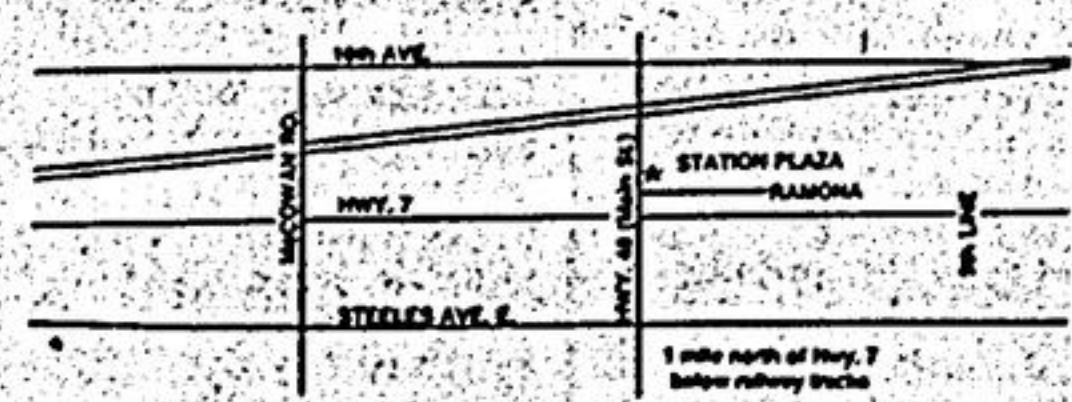
Using a Pumpnickle Bread - cut in small squares - place smoked salmon on bread - then cream cheese - small slice of onion - and top with a caper.

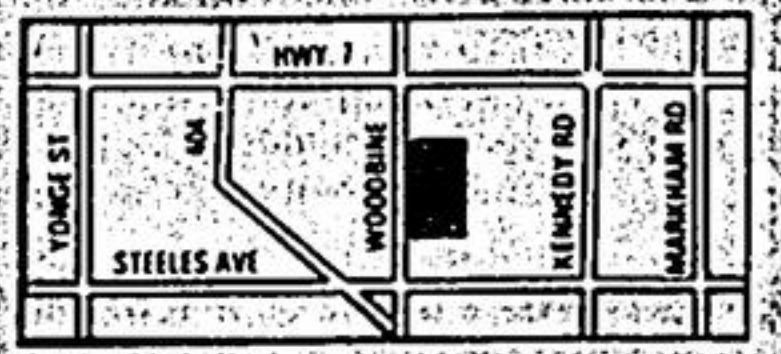
