Born November 8, 1909, to William and Alice Wilson of Pickering Township, she spent most of her childhood years a farm girl.

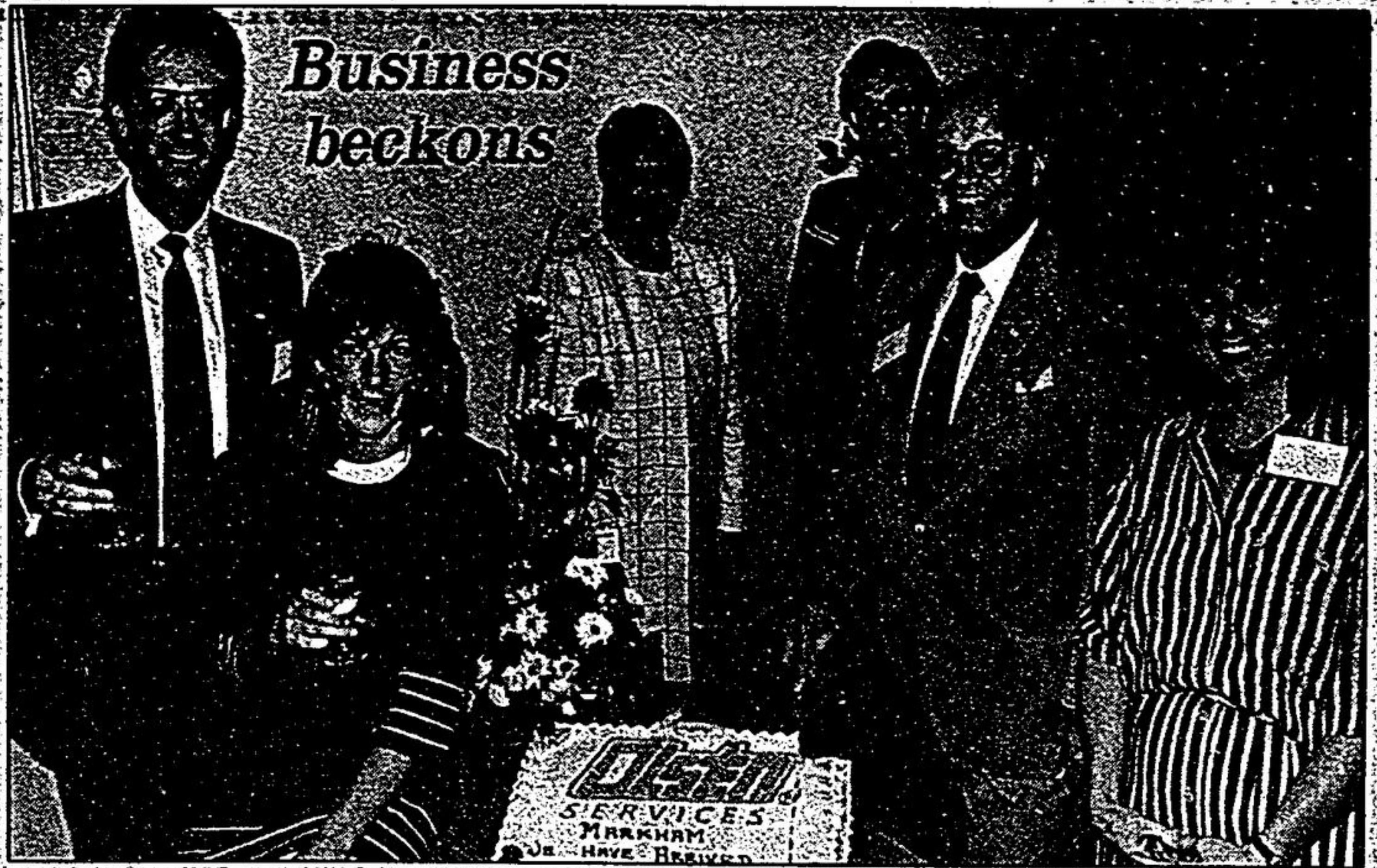
On July 3, 1937, she married Viotta Pennanen and two years later moved to a little farm once situated on Stouffville's Main

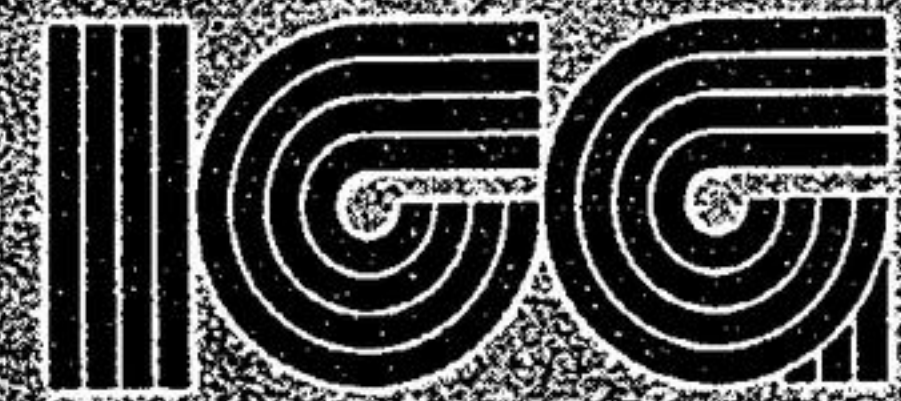
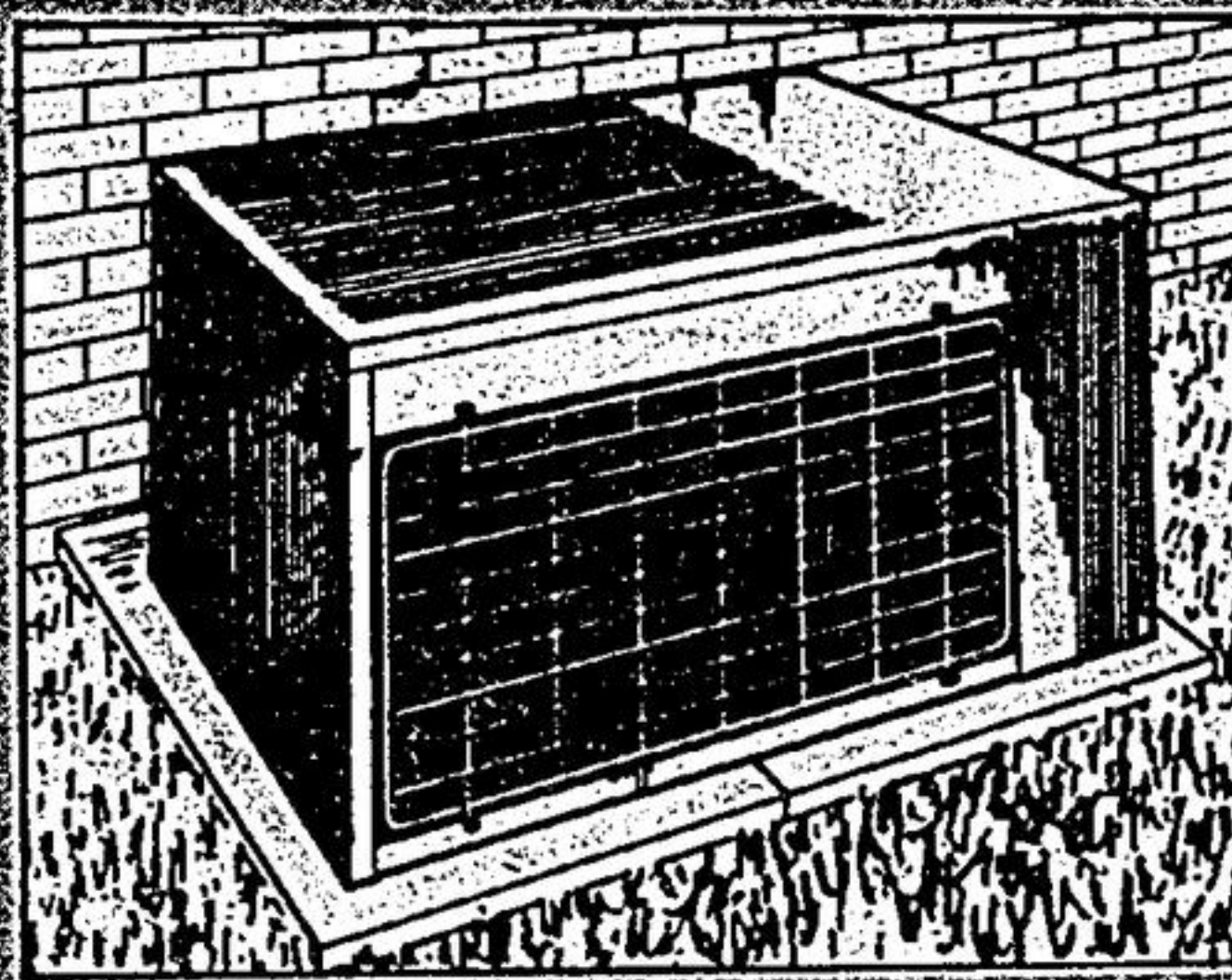
