

Trips offer fun in sun

Who says there's nothing for young Whitchurch-Stouffville teens to do during the summer?

The Recreation Department has all kinds of fun events planned, including trips to a Blue Jays game and Sunshine Beach amusement park.

Summer Youth Trips give youths over age 13 a chance to participate in a number of events they might otherwise be unable to enjoy this summer.

The trips are organized by the Recreation Department, and bus transportation is provided free of charge by McNeil Pharmaceutical.

Along with the Blue Jays and Sunshine Beach, other treks planned for this summer are a concert at Ontario Place and a cycling tour of Toronto.

Adult supervisors accompany all trips, and buses leave from and return to the Recreation Centre on Ninth Line North.

The outing to the Blue Jays game is scheduled for the night of Wednesday, July 29, when the Jays take on the Boston Red Sox. Cost is \$5.25, and the bus leaves

Stouffville at 6 p.m. and returns after the game. There are a limited number of seats for this trip so please book early.

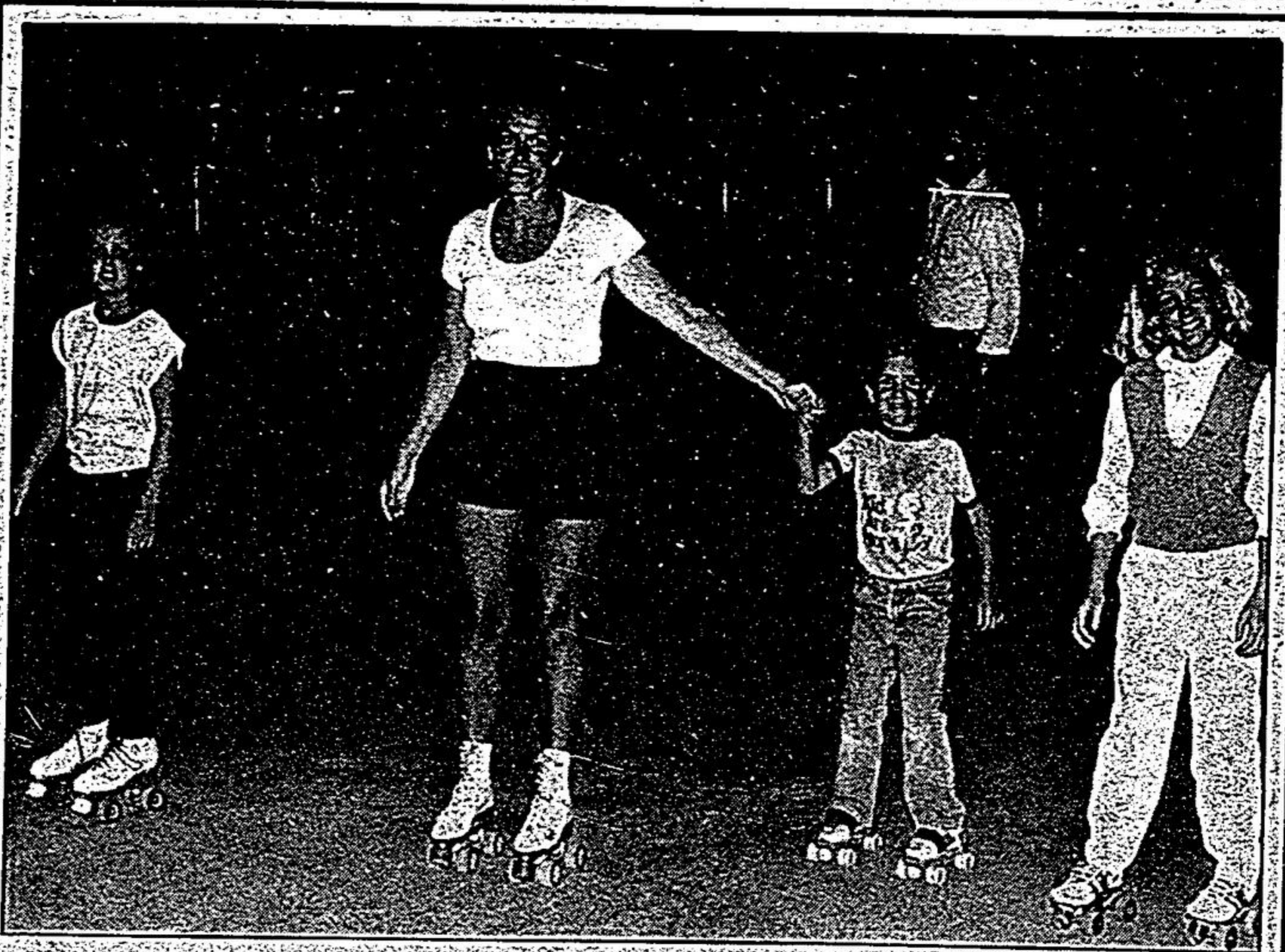
On Wednesday, Aug. 5, a visit to Ontario Place for the rock opera sounds of Dolly De Luxe is planned. The bus leaves at 6 p.m. and returns at about 10:30 p.m. Cost is \$5.

Also, a trip to Sunshine Beach and Water Park is slated for Wednesday, Aug. 26. This amusement park features rides, slides and a wave pool. Participants should bring lunch money. Cost is \$7.95 and the bus departs at 9:30 a.m. returning to Stouffville at 4 p.m.

A bicycle tour of Toronto is another of the planned excursions. Cost will be between \$12 and \$18. A final date for this event has yet to be set.

Adults as well as youths under 13, as long as they are accompanied by a person over 16, are also welcome to participate in the Summer Youth Trips program.

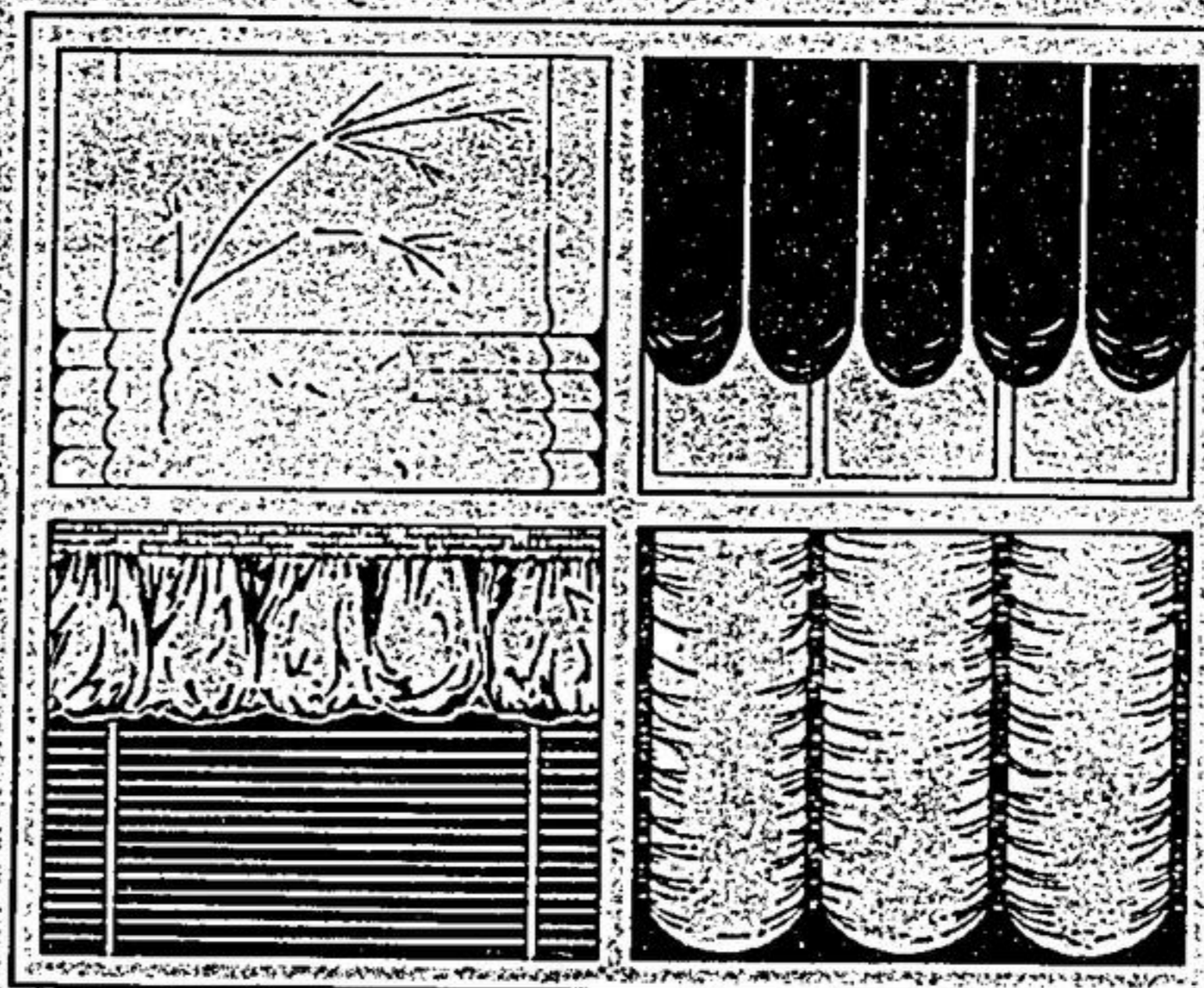
