Ambulance service

Bob Berthelot is a resident of 19th Avenue, Dickson's Hill. He is concerned re the lack of 24-hour ambulance service in Whitechurch-Stouffville and is continuing his relentless fight for round-the-clock ambulance operation here.

Mr. Berthelot's most recent communication is with The Hon. Murray Elston, Minister of Health, Queen's Park, Toronto. His letter reads in part:

Dear Mr. Elston:
Whitechurch-Stouffville is presently enjoying rapid growth. The municipality requires support from you, the Minister of

Health, in order that it may offer emergency ambulance service for those who require it.

Our Town shouldn't have to depend on an ambulance located in Uxbridge or Markham. Often, delays of up to half-an-hour occur because of this.

At present, our ambulance isn't allowed out of the station between midnight and 8 a.m. Often, serious accidents occur during this time.

I urge you to make this a high priority.
