Still too early for local voters

STOUFFVILLE — The majority of Stouffville residents appear undecided as to which party they'll support in Durham-York's upcoming provincial election September 10.

In an informal poll conducted by The Tribune, 44 per cent of respondents spoken to said it's still too early in the candidates' campaign to choose between Ross Stevenson for the Progressive Conservatives, Bill Ballinger for the Liberals, Donna Kelly for the New Democratic Party, or Ken Canning for the Family Coalition Party.

"I don't really know which way I'll go. Both my husband and I still have to read up on the parties some more," one Stouffville resident said.

"All the candidates are new to the riding. I don't really know any of them," said another.

Of those willing to disclose their party preference, the Progressive Conservatives were favored over the Liberals by a two to one margin. The NDP placed a distant third.

"I've always voted conservative, because I feel none of the parties should get in with too much of a majority. If the Liberals win it will be too one-sided," another resident said.

However, one respondent felt "the Liberals deserve a chance. Everyone else has screwed up so far."

Early polls open soon

DURHAM-YORK — Advance polls for the upcoming provincial election will be held at several area locations.

Early voters may cast their ballot at the office of the electoral district returning officer, 24 Toronto St., Uxbridge, from August 29 to September 8 (Sundays excluded).

Stouffville residents may vote at an advance poll in Latham Hall, Park Drive South, September 3, 5 and 7. Other Durham-York locations open those days include Queensville Hall in Queensville, Virginia Senior Citizens Centre in Virginia, Wilfred and Sunderland Town Hall.

All locations are wheelchair-accessible, and voting hours are 11 a.m. to 8 p.m.
