

Airport land committee formed

Dear Editor:
 Since the announcement by the Federal Government to sell about 9,600 acres of land considered to be surplus for airport use, uncertainty about just how this is to be accomplished prompted swift action.
 On July 15 a meeting at Brougham Hall in the Village of Brougham brought together on-

site tenants, previous owners and the media.
 At that meeting Pickering Councillor Norah Stoner attempted to respond to a wide variety of expressed concerns. Urged by her suggestion, a Steering Committee was formed by approximately 24 volunteers.
 Subsequent to an open meet-

ing at Brougham Hall on July 23, at which MP Scott Fennell assured all present that the sell-back process would take at least five years, an Executive Committee was elected.
 Now known as the Committee for Pickering Airport Community, we represent all on-site tenants. Executive members have met on several occasions

in closed sessions. We have formulated a compilation of our most urgent concerns to discuss with federal representatives at a closed meeting, tentatively scheduled on August 27.
 There will be a meeting for on-site tenants only on September 3 at Brougham Hall, 8 p.m. MP Scott Fennell has been asked to attend.

All interested, plan to attend, to meet your Executive Committee members and to hear what we have learned from our initial meeting with Ottawa's representatives.
