

1988 budget increase under consideration

WHITCHURCH — Whitchurch-Stouffville's Protection to Persons and Property committee has recommended to Town Council Kennel Inn be granted a 5.4 per cent increase to their contract.
 This recommendation follows on the heels of recent negotiations, in which Kennel Inn initially requested a 6.7 per cent increase to continue the animal control service they presently

provide for the Town.
 The price tag attached to the service was \$37,485 for a 12 month period between 1986 and 1987. That price will rise to \$39,508 for the same period between 1987 and 1988 pending Council's approval.
 Operating out of Aurora, Kennel Inn has provided Stouffville with the service since 1984.
 The increase, if endorsed, was to have become effected May 1, 1987.

Preston Lake resident revives Latcham Gallery

STOUFFVILLE — The Latcham Gallery is alive and well and once again thriving in the town of Whitchurch-Stouffville thanks to Preston Lake resident Bill Souter.
 On August 26, Gallery Administrator George Schlukbier announced Mr. Souter had made a contribution of \$25,000 pledged over five years to revitalize the Gallery and "stimulate creative passions in the residents of Whitchurch-Stouffville."
 "When speaking with Mr. Sou-

ter and his wife Susan, I was impressed with their philosophy and commitment to the development of local cultural opportunities," he said in a press release. "I have met two individuals who have a commitment and a vision for the future that stimulates the imagination of our entire Gallery organization to build and grow to better serve the community today and tomorrow."
 According to Mr. Souter, his generous donation was not a "spur of the moment thing, but a

strong belief in a cultural way within a community."
 "The heart of any society has to be symbolized by something, be it industry or what have you," he said. "When I read in the papers that Latcham Gallery was having difficulties, I felt it was a devastating loss not only to Latcham but the whole community as well. It's like taking the New York Yankees out of New York."
 After speaking with Mr. Schlukbier and Deen Glover, Mr. Souter said he was impressed by their goals for the Gallery and undertook to guarantee the money over a five year period.

"It's not really a big deal to me, I think it's nice for us as a community," he said. "However, it can't be looked upon as a personal niceness, but simply as recognition of the great community we live in."
