These words were penned by a man who lived 85 years after the apostles — Origen (185-254 A.D.) All churches within about a century after the apostles were practicing infant baptism. Is it possible that the early church could have apostatized so quickly from the teaching of the apostles in this outward, public and notorious practice without one word of dissent or controversy?
 While church history is not our authority these facts should give cause to renewed study of the Biblical arguments in its favour. We believe the Bible does teach infant baptism. In obedience to the Bible we baptize Hilary Herd this Sunday morning.
