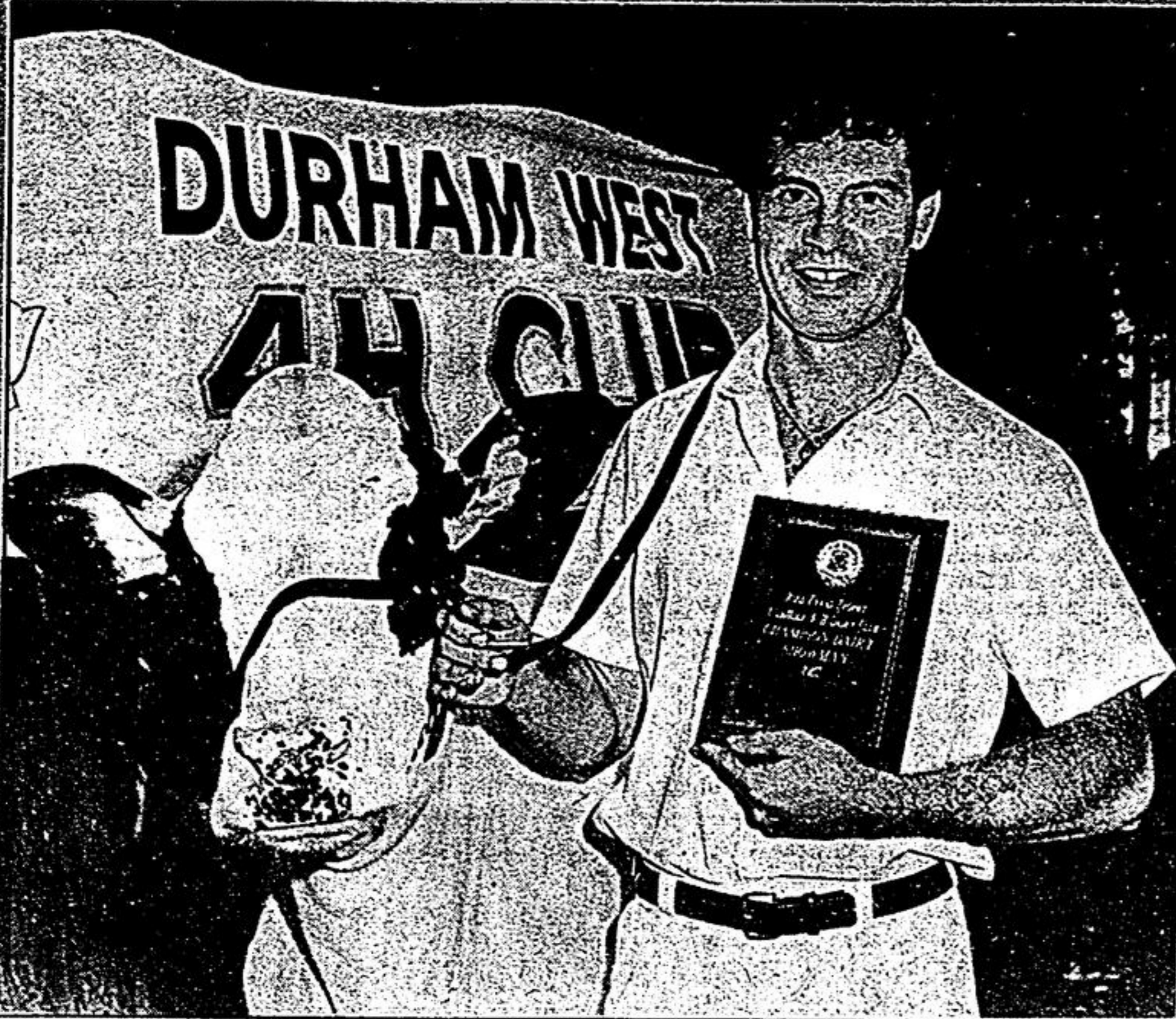
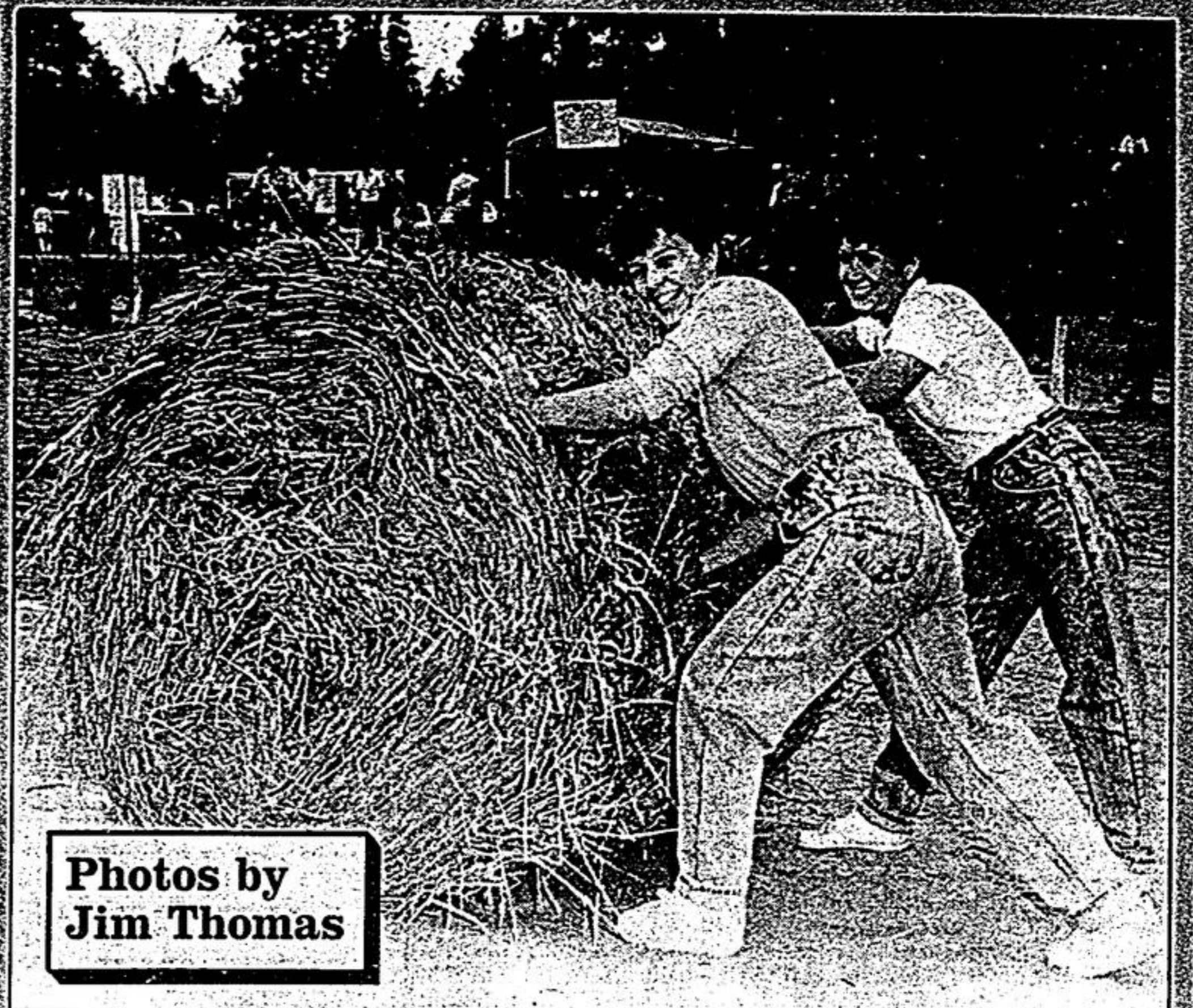


# Happiness is---Uxbridge Fair
