Good books available at varied ability levels

Dear Editor:
Lately, through various media sources, we have heard a great deal about illiteracy across Canada.

It is reported that five million Canadians are classified as illiterate and of those functionally illiterate, one million are completely unable to read or write.

The York Region ACALD, (Association for Children and Adults with Learning Disabilities), has helpful information for those people in our Region. Book lists with high interest, low vocabulary text are available. These give children and adults the opportunity to read interesting books at their own level.

Our Town Library has some of these books as well as a selection of books on audio tapes. Although the tapes were originally designated for the visually impaired, the need for them as material for

the learning disabled has been established.

The ACALD has met with the librarians of York Region Board of Education and, as a result, share information via a quarterly newsletter "Library Corner" that is sent to the schools.

Much is happening in York Region, and other areas are urged to begin similar projects.

If you or your child have a learning disability and are unaware of the Association, they can

be a great source of information. They are listed in the telephone book under "Learning Disabilities Association."

York Region School and public libraries should be commended for the resources they've made available, but more books are always welcome.

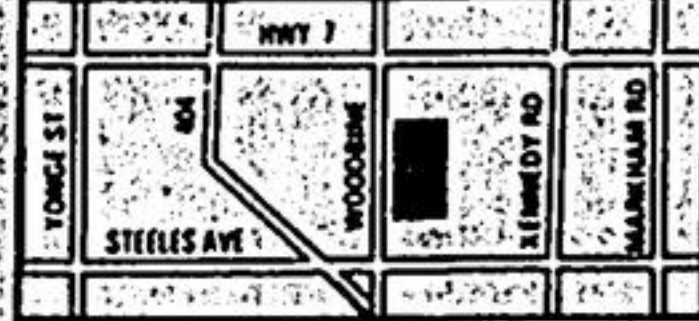
