Skating club remembers Stouffville ice tradition

The Whitchurch-Stouffville Senior Adult Skating Club is the revival of a long-time Town tradition. The Club was started three years ago, thanks to a grant from the federal government's New Horizons program, and now adults of all ages, many of them seniors, take to the ice Tuesday nights from September to April at the Whitchurch-Stouffville Recreation Centre.

"Many of members of the Club can remember when Wednesday and Saturday nights in the 1930's

and '40's were speed skating nights in the old Stouffville Arena," said Club secretary Bud Sanderson. "In a way this is a return to those times for many of them." There are over 100 members in the Club, and all adult skaters are welcome to participate, not just seniors.

Memberships cost \$5 to join, and the price of skating is \$2 a night for members and \$3 for non-members. The fun begins at 7:30 p.m. and continues till 9 p.m. every Tuesday till April.

A number of the older skaters

flying round the ice are on speed skates, and Sanderson said this is because many of them were speed skaters as youngsters.
