Lisa Reitch took the Ladies' Singles crown, while Don Lloyd won the honors in the Men's Singles division.

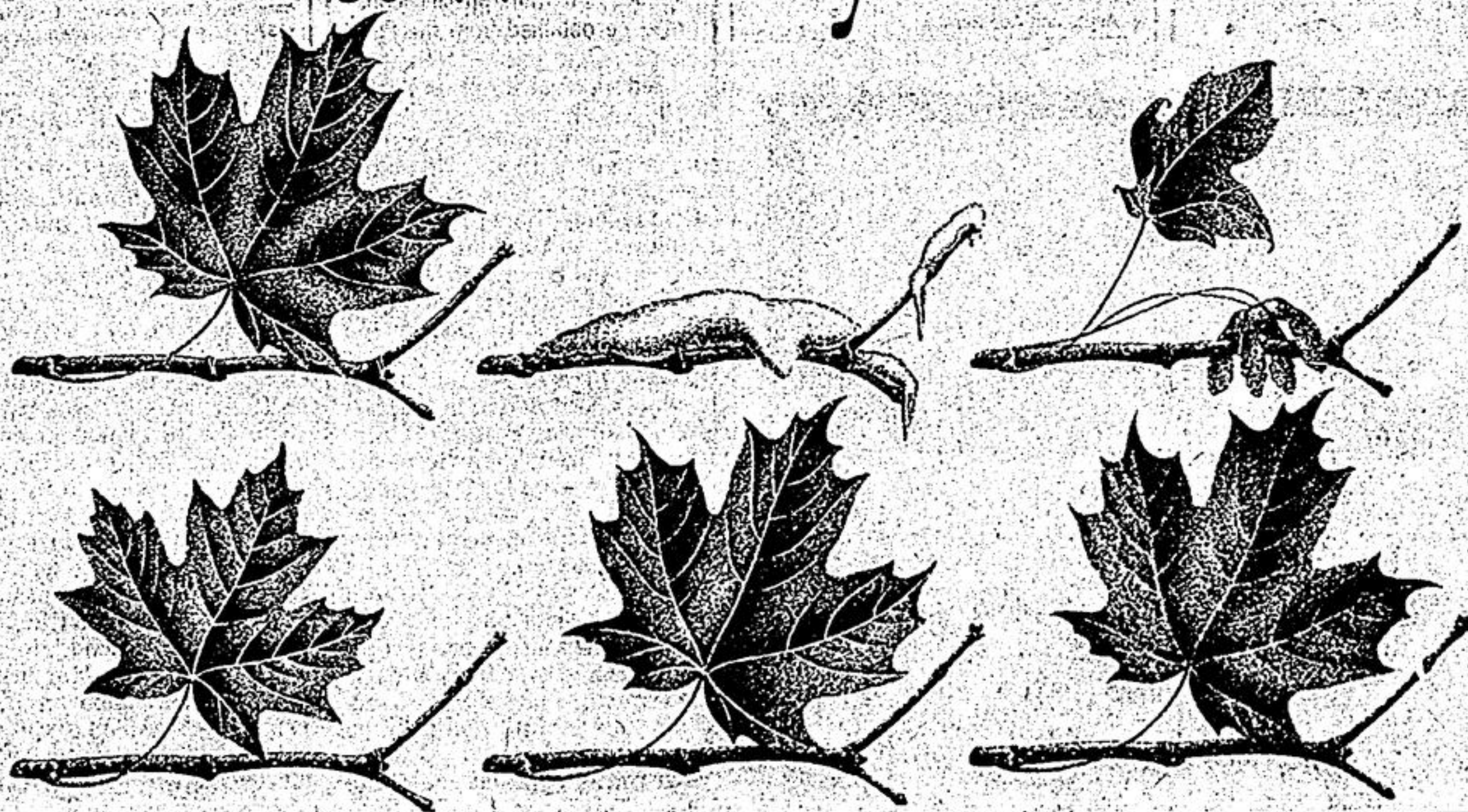
