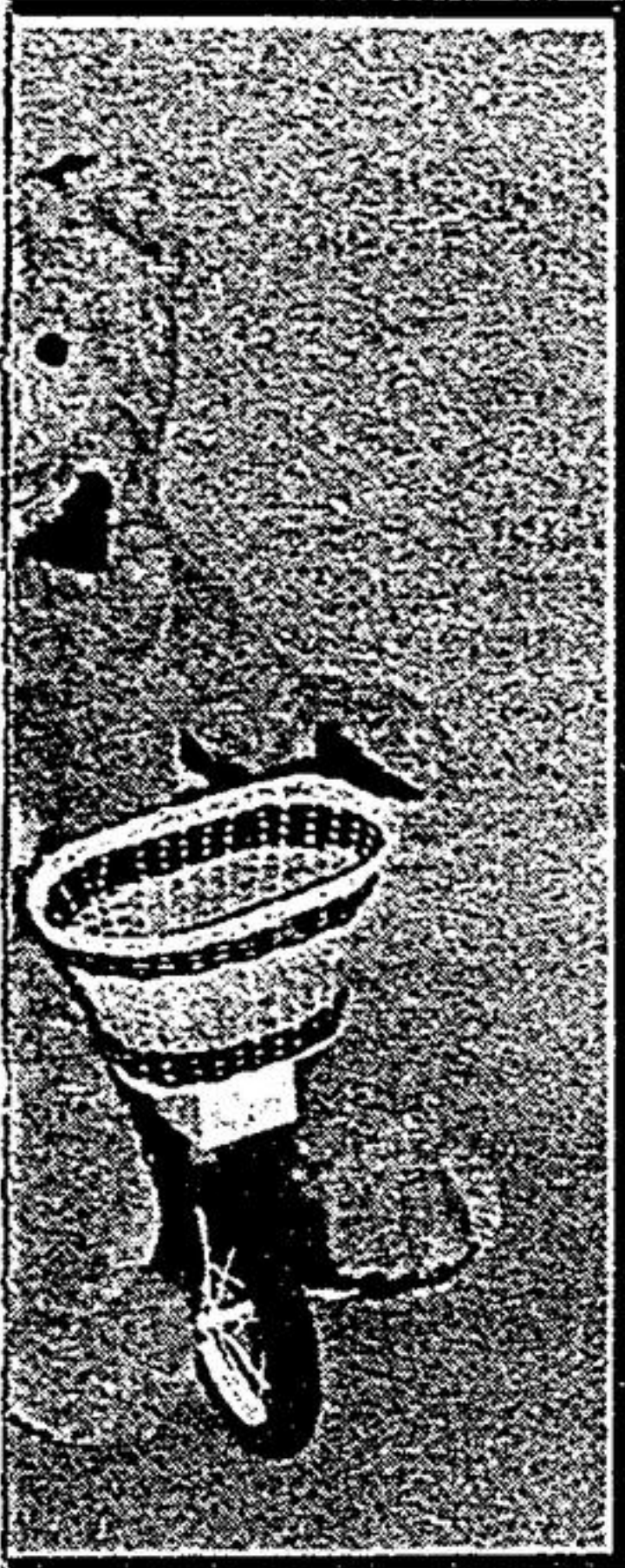
Stories, songs, rhymes and fingerplays will be the order of the day. Parents are welcome to attend. Advance registration is necessary.
