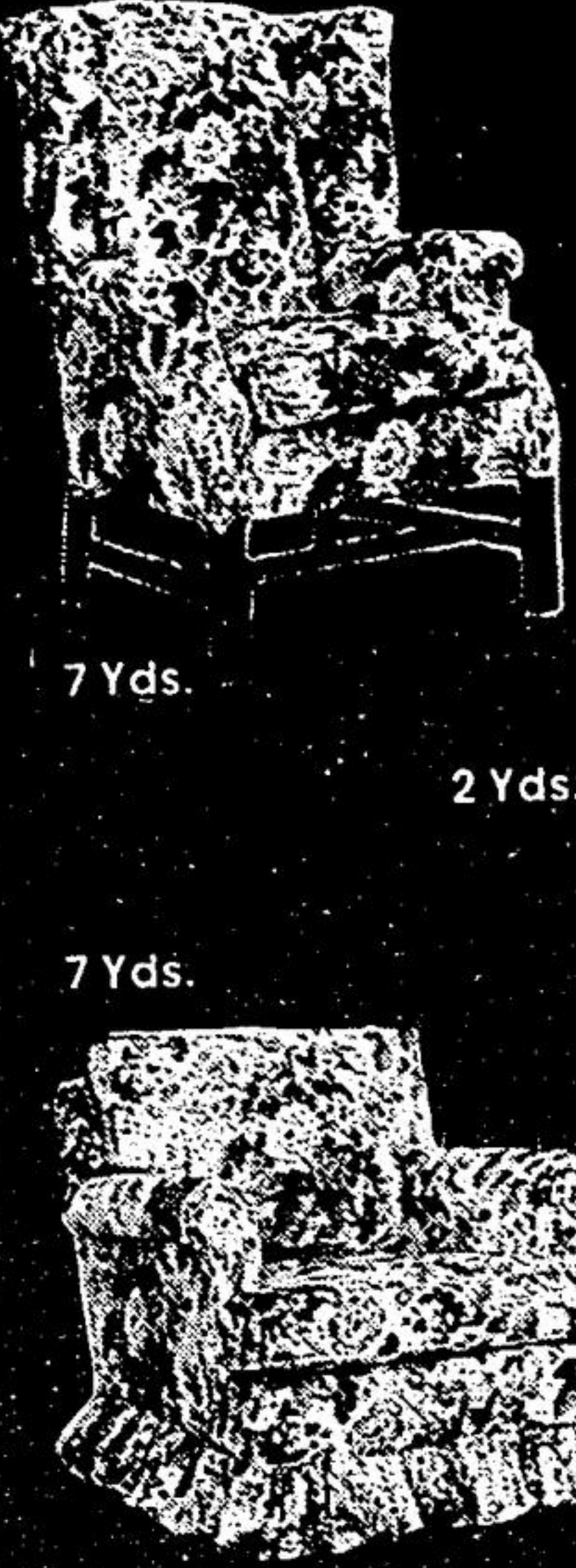

This is just a reminder of the C.D.C.A.A meeting Wednesday evening at 8 p.m. in the Masonic Hall.

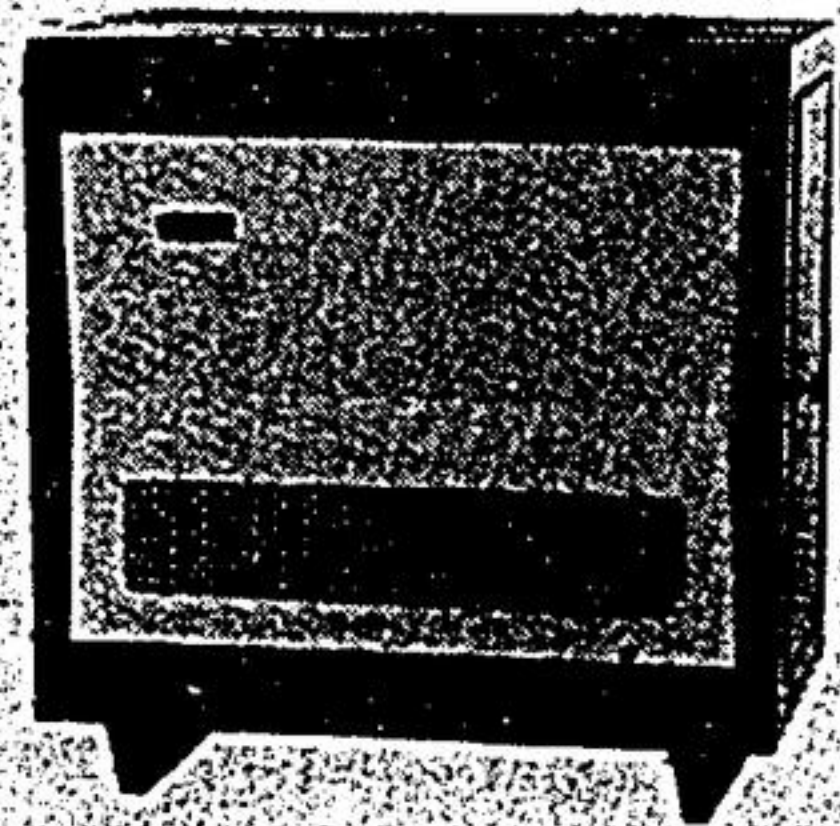

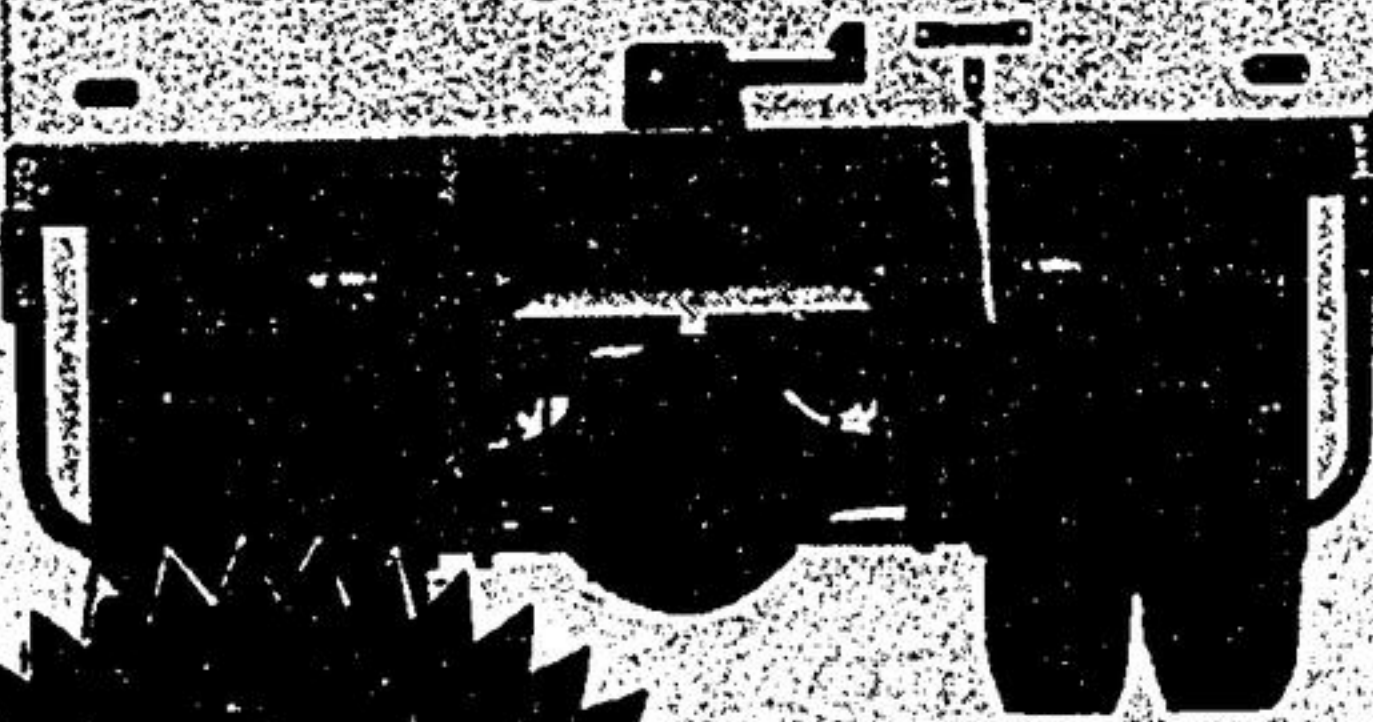

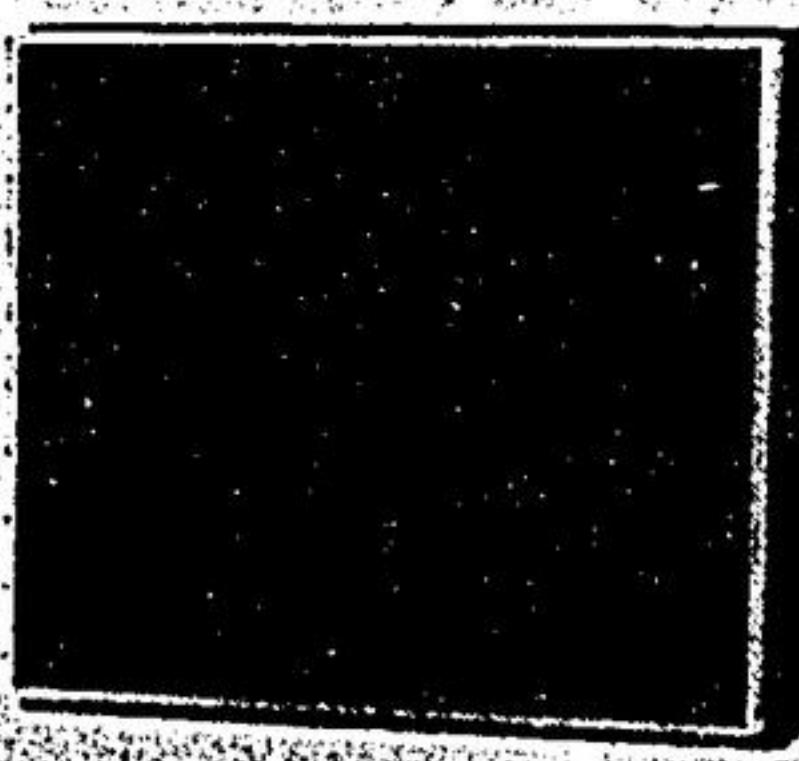
