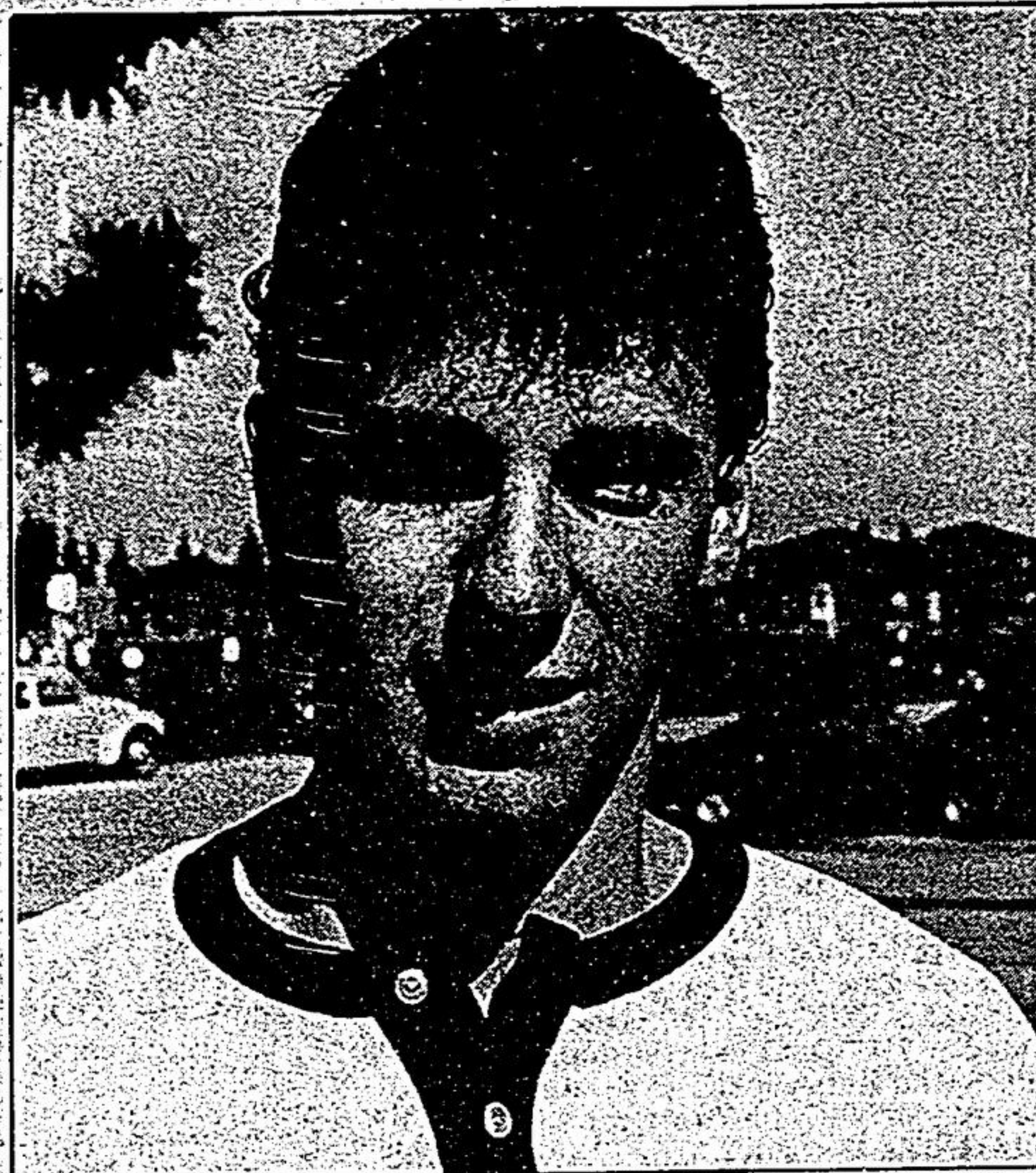


Personality Focus
