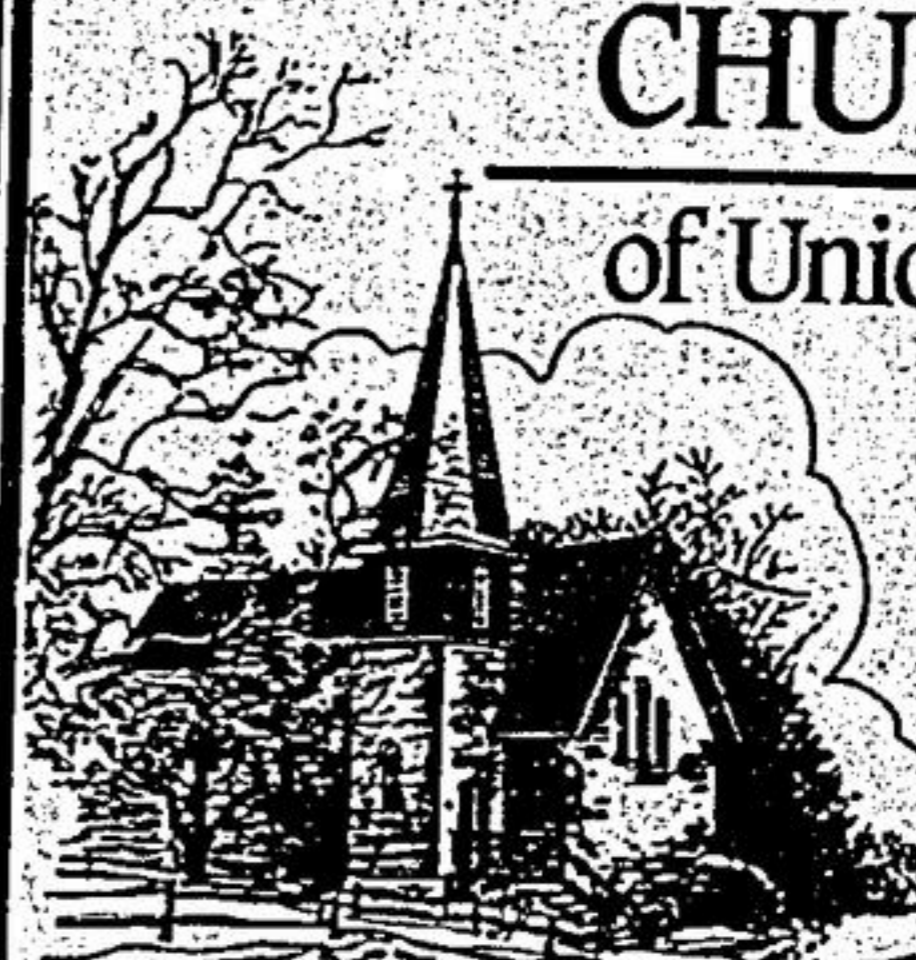

The first question of the Geneva Catechism asks, "What is the chief end of man?" and answers it, "To know God by whom he was created." Some who would endorse this statement enthusiastically would conceive of knowing God in a narrowly pietistic manner, separating it from sound doctrine. "Sound doctrine is important," they may say, "but it is a matter of the head, while knowing God is a matter of the heart."  
This unbiblical bifurcation is evident for example in thinking on the Trinity. To evince orthodoxy many can quote the classic formulation of "One essence, Three persons" but it conjures up in their minds images of abstract and abstract theory. It is a matter for theologians but not laymen, the head not the heart. Such a rendering assuages what God has joined together seriously undermining what it means to know God. Understanding the Trinity is at the heart of what it means to know God. "It is only when we contemplate this Trinity that we know who and what God is." (Herman Bavinck)  
We are studying the Bible's teaching and the church's confession of this truth in history trying to make it devotionally relevant to our lives today. Our purpose is to study Scripture's teaching on the Triune God carefully so we might know Him better.  
The study is Wednesday evenings at 7:30 p.m. at 70 Woodmans' Court in Unionville. There is babysitting and all are welcome who wish to pursue a deeper understanding of God's revelation of Himself.
