THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK WIDENING AND RECONSTRUCTION OF KENNEDY ROAD (YR 3) AND AURORA ROAD (YR 15)

THE COUNCIL OF THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK PROPOSES TO PASS A BY-LAW AUTHORIZING:

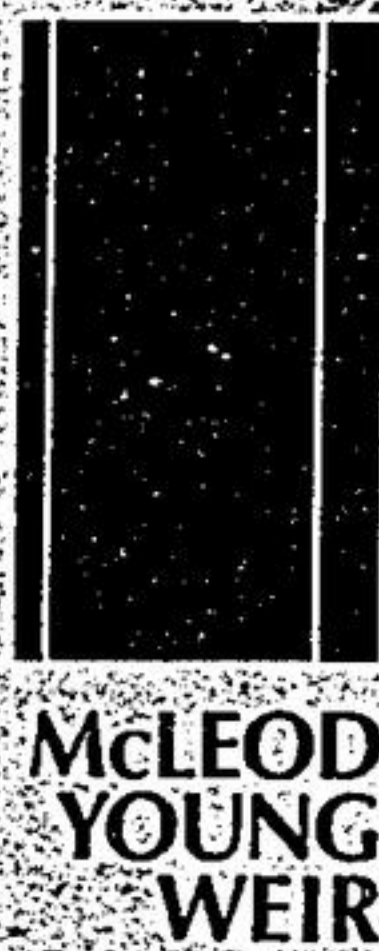
- (a) the widening and reconstruction of Kennedy Road (YR 3) in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville from a point approximately 75 metres south of Aurora Road (YR 15) to a point approximately 700 metres north of Aurora Road (YR 15) to a basic width of 36 metres to provide a basic two lane roadway with additional widenings for turning lanes at the intersection with Aurora Road (YR 15) and William Linton Trail;
- (b) the widening and reconstruction of Aurora Road (YR 15) in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville from a point approximately 200 metres west of Kennedy Road (YR 3) to a point approximately 150 metres east of Kennedy Road (YR 3) to a basic width of 36 metres to provide a basic two lane roadway with additional widenings for turning lanes at the intersection with Kennedy Road (YR 3); and
- (c) the construction of turning lanes on Aurora Road (YR 15) in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville at its proposed intersection with Forestview Trail approximately 450 metres east of Kennedy Road (YR 3).

Pursuant to section 301 of the Municipal Act, the Engineering Committee of the Regional Council will, at its meeting to be held at 10:00 a.m. on the 1st day of December, 1987, in the Council Chambers at the Regional Administrative Building located at 62 Bayview Avenue, Newmarket, hear any person who claims that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the by-law and who applies to be heard. Anyone wishing to be heard is requested to advise Robert Vernon, Regional Clerk, (Telephone 895-1231 or 362-2464 Extension 210). If any party entitled to be heard does not attend at the hearing the Committee may proceed in his absence and he will not be entitled to any further notice in the proceedings.

The proposed by-law and plans showing the proposed works may be inspected at the office of Ronald Gee, Director of Planning and Design, at the Regional Engineering Building located on Woodbine Avenue (YR 8) one and one-quarter miles north of Aurora Road (YR 15) (Telephone 895-2303 or 364-8731).
