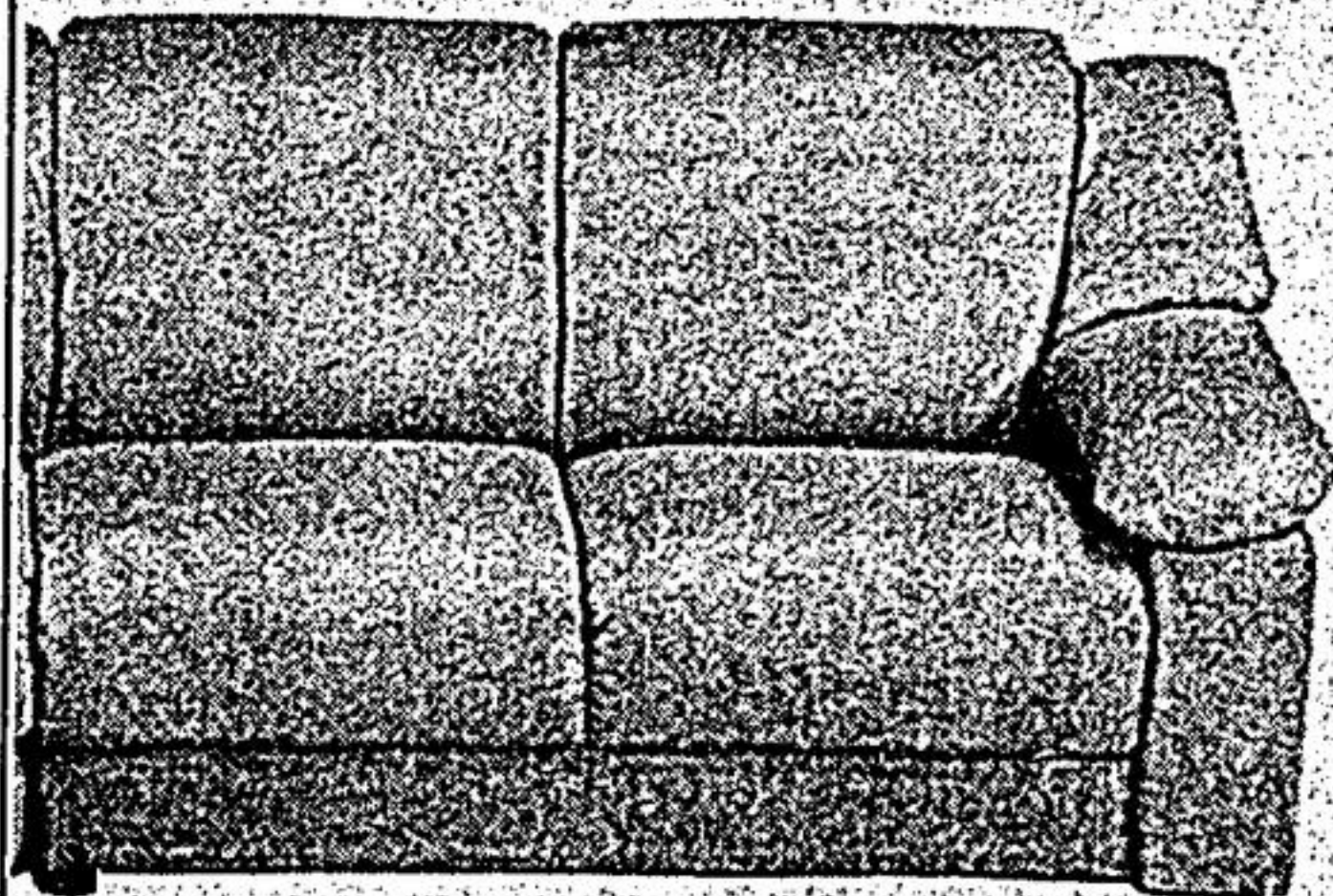
Street level look-see

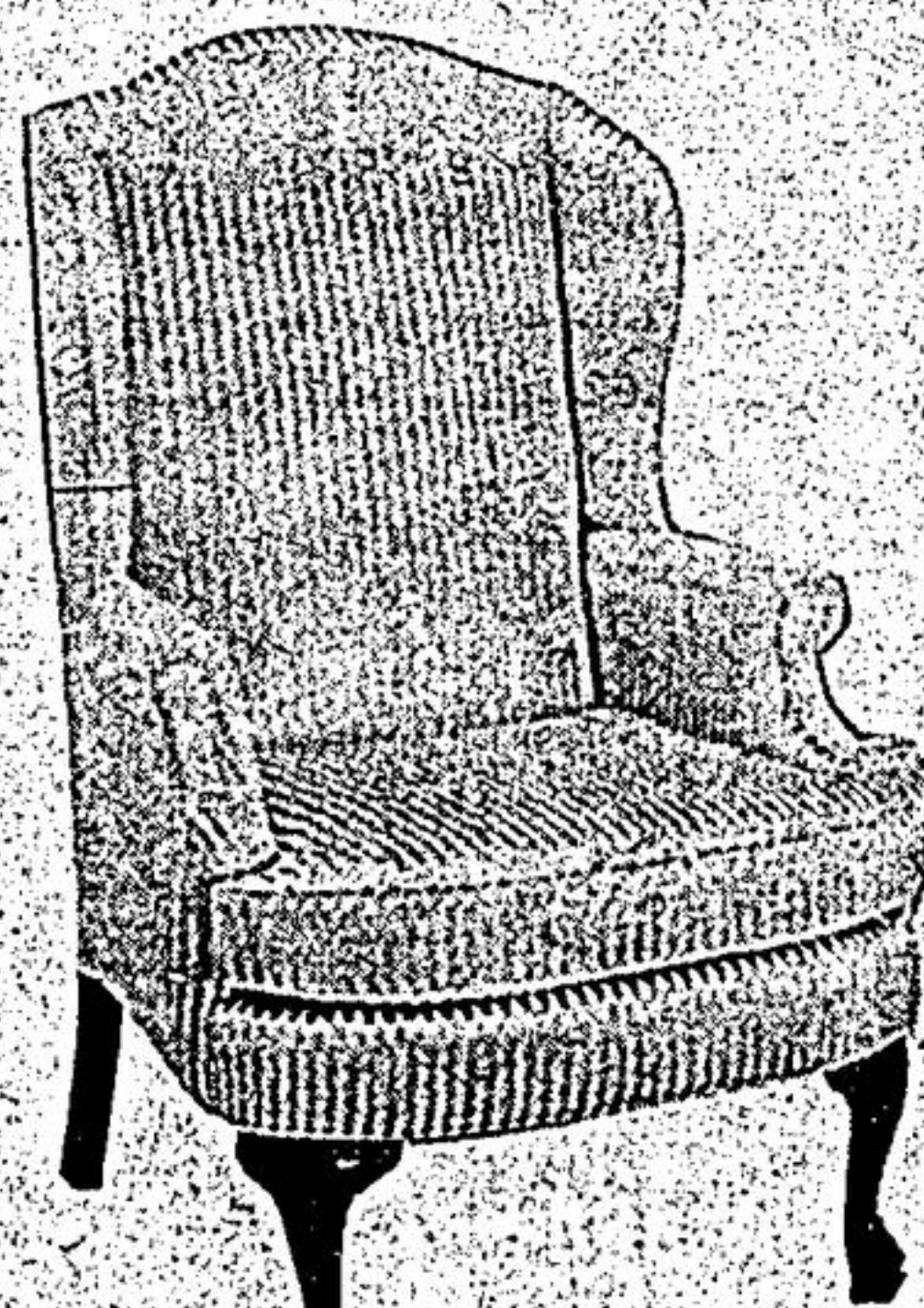

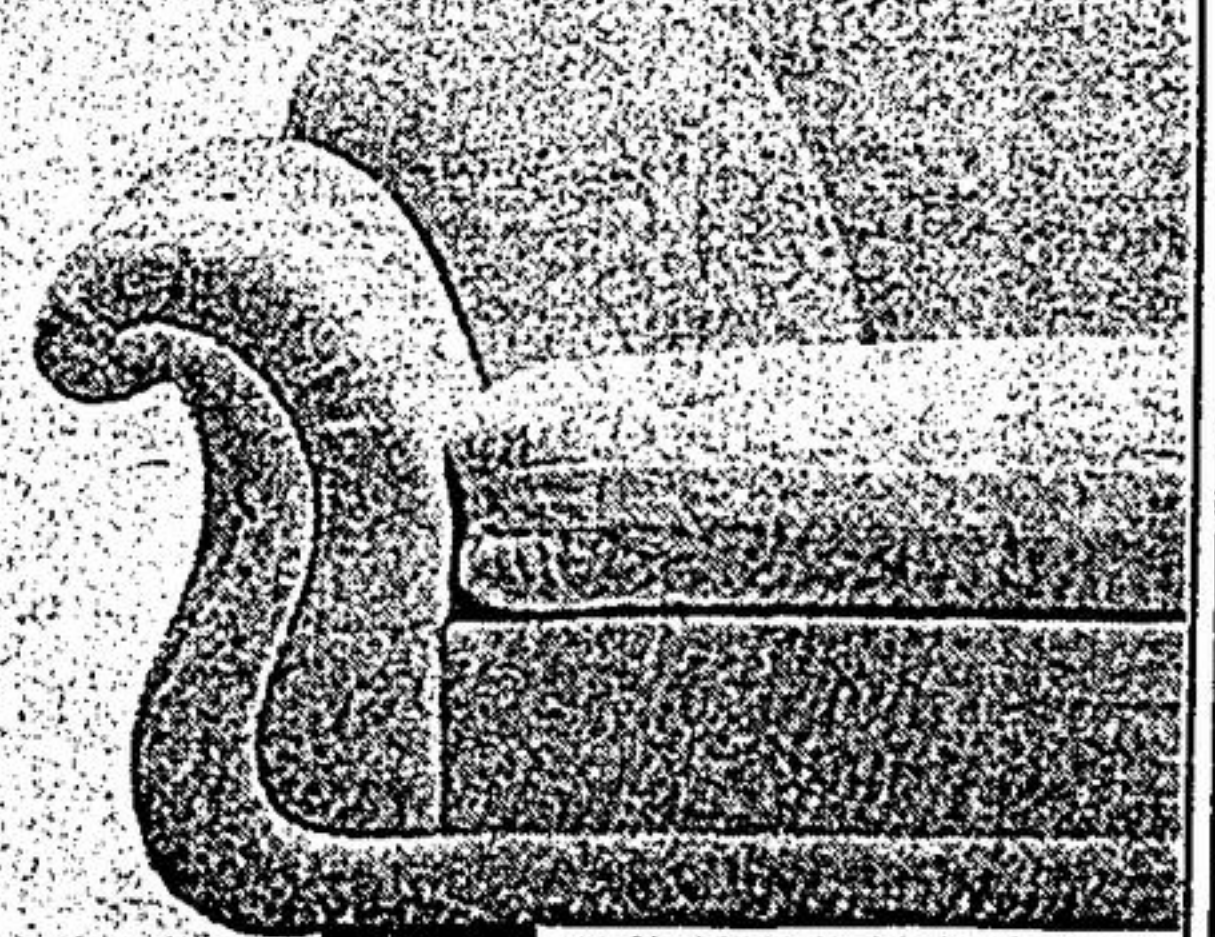
