

**Born To Shop***Deb Bodine Champion***Flea market has bargains for everyone**

I have made a discovery that is destined to become my favorite weekend activity, even surpassing the other mind-blowing experiences that crowd my scintillating Saturdays and Sundays — like laundry and watching Mr. C snooze on the couch.

I can only assume that it has been a carefully calculated cover-up contrived by Mr. C that I haven't previously discovered, the Big Flea Market at Stouffville Sales Barn. He knows me too well.

Everything from whoopee cushions to fine oak furniture, party dresses to pet supplies can be found at discount prices at the Big Flea Market. Vendors crowd the building, upstairs and down, with the best they have to offer (a depressing thought in some cases, but there is definitely enough to make the adventure worthwhile).

One vendor was selling good quality party dresses for children at \$13.99 for the wee ones and \$20 to \$23.99 for the older girls. Included in the selection were velveteen suits for infants, complete with bow tie and vest, are \$15.99.

A walk through the barn reveals a long list of bargains. Socks for men, women and boys are just \$9.99 for a dozen pairs. Oversized Mickey Mouse sweatshirts sell for just \$8 each. Cotton shorts with a Mickey Mouse print are just \$10. An oversized (rather anorexic-looking) mechanical Mickey Mouse sits in a chair and captivates the tiniest visitors to the sales barn by chatting with them and offering them a lollipop.

Lurking in the shadows of a clothing rack in an adjacent stall is the source of Mickey's voice speaking into a microphone. "Truly a man of vision and good taste," he approached me as I perused his racks and asked, "Have you always been this gorgeous?" to which I replied an emphatic "Yes."

At one booth I found a nice selection of children's books, including Beatrix Potter hardcovers, such as *The Tale of Jemima Puddle-duck*, for just \$2.49, suggested list price \$5.95. The Treasury of Literature for Children, a large colorfully illustrated anthology, was \$8.99.

Christmas albums, by many leading recording artists, can be purchased for \$6.99. I even unearthed an album that I had when I was a small child, with performers such as Red Skelton, Gene Autry and Captain Kangaroo crooning the tunes. (Not quite antique, but painfully close.)

Unpackaged new toys are a terrific buy. Large Care Bears are \$8, and Care Bear Cousins Cub are \$5. Pound Puppies start at \$5 for the newborn size to \$25 for the barking model. Huggabunch dolls (boy only) are \$10.

For the Star Wars aficionado, action figures from the various movies are just \$.75 each, or 10 for \$5. Play tents that sell for \$42.99 in a current catalogue are just \$24.95.

For \$12.95 you can purchase a personalized storybook. Using a computer, the text in a variety of storybooks can be custom designed to include the names of people you know. Titles include *My Christmas Wish* and *The Magic Dreidel*.

Home decorators will find a myriad of items to choose from: silk floral arrangements, placemats, chair cushions, lace curtains — even stereos. An attractive camel-back sofa, loveseat and chair ensemble in a floral with dark grey background is just \$995. A rectangular oak table with four press back chairs is \$799.

Adjoining the barn itself is a National Sports Centre outlet, featuring many good buys on sports equipment and activewear. 1986 skiwear is currently 50 per cent off, bringing jackets that normally retail for \$224 to \$112. Sweatshirts featuring the store's logo are just \$9.99, as are the children's sweatshirts with the Coke label.

Selected mens' and ladies' track pants are reduced to \$14.99. Ladies' nylon fleecewear is just \$9.99 each piece. Dolfin reversible sweatshirts are currently \$14.99, regularly up to \$44.99, and will drop to \$9.99 in the Christmas Big 40 Sale Dec. 8, 9 and 10.

All this, and I never even went upstairs.
