Night School

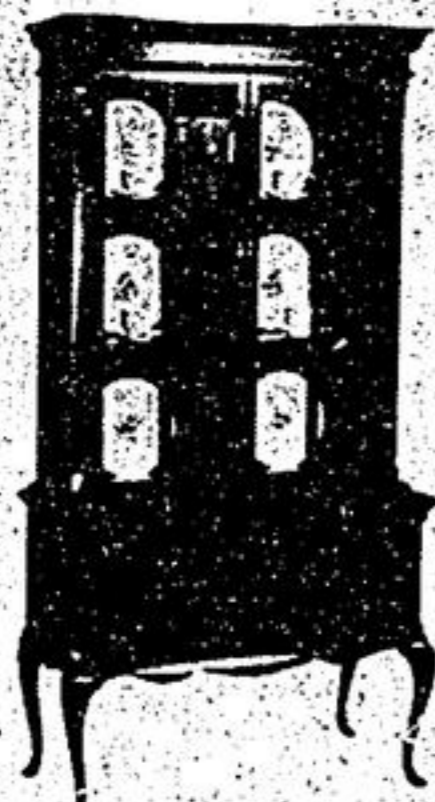

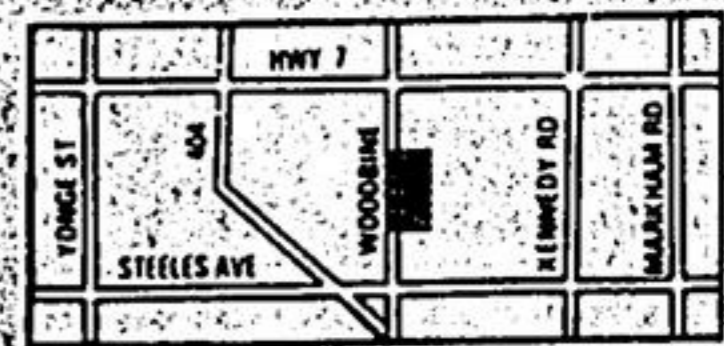
