

Late Rose Crowder Stouffville resident more than 50 years

STOUFFVILLE — Rev. Douglas Gray of Stouffville Missionary Church conducted the service Jan. 17 from the O'Neill Funeral Home for Mrs. Gordon Crowder following her passing, Jan. 14 at Parkview Home. She was 92.

Mrs. Crowder, the former Rose Andrews, was born near Sutton, one of nine children in the family of Edmund and Sarah Ann (Keeley) Andrews.

Mr. and Mrs. Crowder and family moved from Sharon to Stouffville in 1933. They resided first in the east end of town, then at the corner of Market and Somerville Streets and la-

ter Harold Avenue and Albert Street South.

Mr. Crowder predeceased his wife 11 years ago.

Mrs. Crowder spent the past nine years in Parkview Apartments and Parkview Home. She is the youngest and last of a family of seven boys and two girls.

Prior to her marriage, Mrs. Crowder attended the Free Methodist Church at Holt and later the United Church in Queensville. She was a member in the congregation of the Missionary Church, Stouffville.

Mrs. Crowder was a kindly lady with a wide cir-

cle of friends. She enjoyed doing needlework and it gave her great pleasure to donate these beautiful items as gifts to her grandchildren.
